## INTRODUCTION


## SETUP

### 1. Connecting Your Sega Genesis Console

Ensure your Sega Genesis console is properly connected to your television and power source. Refer to your console's manual for detailed connection instructions if needed.

### 2. Inserting the Game Cartridge

1. Turn off your Sega Genesis console before inserting or removing any game cartridges.
2. Hold the Last Battle cartridge with the label facing forward (towards the front of the console).
3. Gently but firmly insert the cartridge into the cartridge slot on top of the Sega Genesis console until it clicks into place. Do not force the cartridge.

### 3. Connecting Controllers

Plug your Sega Genesis controller(s) into the controller ports on the front of the console. Last Battle is a single-player game, so only one controller is required.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Starting the Game

After inserting the cartridge and connecting your controller, turn on your Sega Genesis console. The game should load automatically and display the title screen.

## 2. Basic Controls

Familiarize yourself with the standard Sega Genesis controller layout:

- **Directional Pad (D-Pad):** Move Aarzak left, right, up, and down.
- **A Button:** Jump.
- **B Button:** Kick attack.
- **C Button:** Punch attack.
- **Start Button:** Pause the game, access menu options.

## 3. Gameplay Objectives

As Aarzak, your primary goal is to navigate through various stages, defeat hordes of enemies, and overcome powerful bosses to liberate your people. The game features an intricate maze of passages that require exploration to progress.

## 4. Power-Up System

To enhance Aarzak's abilities, defeat as many enemies as possible. As your power bar fills, Aarzak will gain increased strength and more effective attacks. This power-up is crucial for overcoming tougher opponents and bosses.

## 5. Continuing Your Game

Last Battle does not feature an in-game save function. However, if you reach a new act and lose all your lives, you can continue from the beginning of that act. At the title screen, hold down the **A**, **B**, and **C** buttons simultaneously, then press **Start** to access a stage select feature for acts you have already reached.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### 1. Cartridge Cleaning

If the game fails to start or experiences glitches, the cartridge connectors may be dirty. Gently clean the gold connectors on the bottom of the cartridge using a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol. Allow the connectors to dry completely before reinserting the cartridge into the console.

### 2. Storage

Store your Last Battle cartridge in its original case or a protective storage container in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and humidity. This will help prevent damage and prolong the life of the game.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Game Does Not Start

- Ensure the cartridge is fully and correctly inserted into the console.
- Clean the cartridge connectors as described in the Maintenance section.
- Verify that your Sega Genesis console is properly connected to power and your television.
- Try another game cartridge to determine if the issue is with the console or the Last Battle cartridge.

### Controller Not Responding

- Ensure the controller cable is securely plugged into the console's controller port.
- Try using a different controller if available.
- Test the controller in a different game to isolate the problem.

## Difficulty with Bosses or Levels

- Utilize the power-up system by defeating more standard enemies to increase Aarzak's strength before facing challenging bosses.
- Experiment with different attack combinations (punch and kick) and movement strategies.
- Explore all areas of a stage; sometimes hidden items or paths can provide an advantage. For example, in the first map, returning to the top after completing the first puzzle level can grant enhanced defense.
