INTRODUCTION

SETUP

To begin playing Gran Turismo 2, follow these steps:

- 1. Insert Disc 1 (Arcade Mode):** Place the Gran Turismo 2 Arcade Mode disc into your PlayStation console.
- 2. Power On:** Turn on your PlayStation console and television.
- 3. Controller Connection:** Ensure your PlayStation controller is properly connected. For an enhanced experience, a compatible racing wheel accessory can be used.
- 4. Start Game:** The game should load automatically. If not, navigate to the disc icon on the PlayStation menu and select Gran Turismo 2.
- 5. Disc 2 (Simulation Mode):** The game comes on two CDs. Disc 2 is for the Gran Turismo Simulation Mode, which offers a more in-depth, single-player experience. You will be prompted to insert Disc 2 when accessing this mode.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Gran Turismo 2 features two distinct gameplay modes:

Arcade Mode (Disc 1)

This mode is designed for quick races and immediate action. It supports both single-player and two-player split-screen competition. Winning races in Arcade Mode can unlock hidden cars.

- **Race Selection:** Choose from various tracks and car classes.
- **Car Selection:** Select from a range of pre-tuned vehicles.
- **Multplayer:** Engage in head-to-head races with a friend.

Gran Turismo Simulation Mode (Disc 2)

The Simulation Mode offers a comprehensive and realistic racing career experience. This mode is single-player only and focuses on progression, car acquisition, and customization.

- **Earning Credits:** Win races to earn in-game credits.
- **Car Purchase & Upgrades:** Use credits to buy new cars and purchase performance-enhancing parts. Over 400 car models are available, each with unique performance and handling characteristics.

- **Driving Licenses:** Pass a series of driving tests to obtain licenses. These licenses are crucial for unlocking new races and tracks.
- **Memory Card Transfer:** Licenses and customized cars from Simulation Mode can be transferred to Arcade Mode for use in head-to-head races.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your Gran Turismo 2 game discs and PlayStation console will ensure long-lasting enjoyment.

- **Disc Handling:** Always hold discs by the edges. Avoid touching the reflective surface.
- **Cleaning Discs:** If a disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store discs in their original case when not in use to protect them from dust and scratches. Keep cases away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Console Care:** Ensure your PlayStation console is placed on a stable, well-ventilated surface. Keep vents clear of obstructions to prevent overheating.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing Gran Turismo 2, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Disc Read Error:**
If the console displays a "Disc Read Error" or fails to load the game:
 - Check the disc for scratches or smudges. Clean the disc as described in the Maintenance section.
 - Ensure the disc is inserted correctly into the console.
 - Try restarting the PlayStation console.
 - If possible, test the disc on another PlayStation console to determine if the issue is with the disc or your console.
- **Game Freezing/Crashing:**
If the game freezes or crashes during gameplay:
 - Ensure your PlayStation console has adequate ventilation and is not overheating.
 - Clean the game disc.
 - Restart the console and try again.
 - Ensure your memory card has sufficient free space if saving game progress.
- **Controller Not Responding:**
If your controller is not working correctly:
 - Check that the controller is securely plugged into the correct port on the console.
 - Try another controller if available to rule out a faulty controller.
 - Restart the console.
