

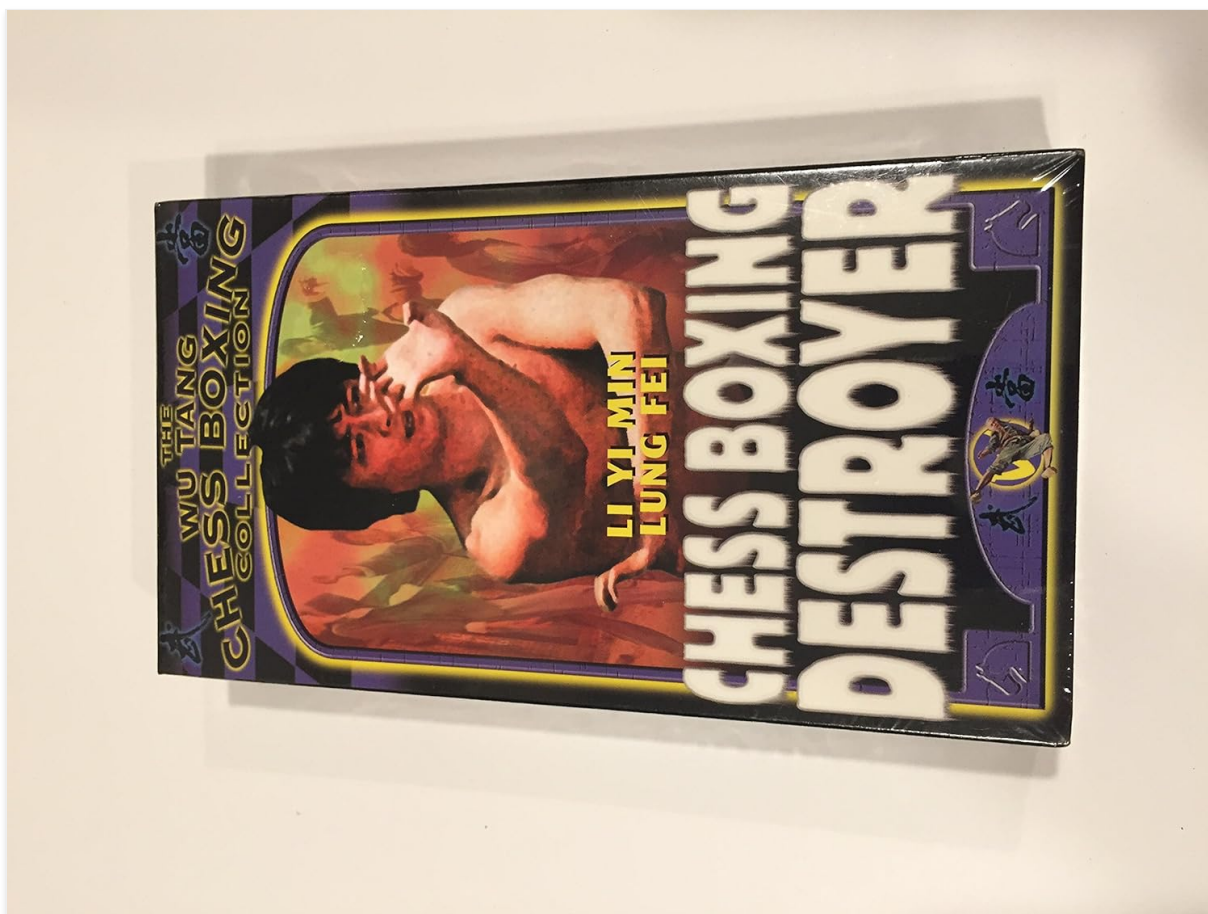

Xenon Chess Boxing Destroyer VHS Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper handling, playback, and care of your Chess Boxing Destroyer VHS tape. This product is a standard VHS format video cassette featuring the film 'Chess Boxing Destroyer', distributed by Xenon. It stars actors Ming-Tsai Wu and Cheng-Wu Yang.

2. SETUP

To play your VHS tape, you will need a functional Video Cassette Recorder (VCR) and a television or monitor with appropriate input connections.

1. **Connect your VCR:** Ensure your VCR is properly connected to your television or monitor. Typically, this involves connecting an RCA composite video cable (yellow for video) and audio cables (red for right audio, white for left audio) from the VCR's output to the TV's input. - **Stop:** Press the **STOP** button to end playback and eject the tape.
- **Rewind (REW):** Press the **REW** button to quickly rewind the tape.
- **Fast Forward (FF):** Press the **FF** button to quickly advance the tape.
- **Tracking:** If the picture quality is poor or distorted, adjust the **TRACKING** control on your VCR until the image stabilizes.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your VHS tape and VCR will ensure optimal performance and longevity.

- **Tape Storage:** Store VHS tapes vertically in their cases, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and strong magnetic fields (e.g., speakers, televisions).
- **Handling:** Avoid touching the magnetic tape itself. Always handle the cassette by its plastic casing.
- **Dust Prevention:** Keep tapes in their protective sleeves or cases when not in use to prevent dust accumulation.
- **VCR Cleaning:** Periodically clean your VCR's heads using a specialized VHS head cleaning tape. Refer to your VCR's manual for specific cleaning instructions.
- **Rewind After Use:** Always rewind the tape to the beginning after viewing to prevent tension on the tape and ensure it's ready for the next playback.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during playback, consider the following common solutions:

- **No Picture/Sound:**
 - Ensure all cables are securely connected between the VCR and TV.
 - Verify the TV is set to the correct input channel (AV, Video 1, etc.).

- Check that the VCR is powered on and in Play mode.
- **Poor Picture Quality (Snowy/Distorted):**
 - Adjust the VCR's **TRACKING** control.
 - Clean the VCR heads with a cleaning tape.
 - Ensure the tape is not damaged or worn.
- **Tape Jammed in VCR:**
 - Do not force the tape out. Turn off the VCR, then try turning it back on and pressing **EJECT**.
 - If the issue persists, consult a VCR repair specialist.
