INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND PLAYBACK

Preparing for Playback

Before playing your CD, ensure your CD player or computer's disc drive is clean and free of dust. Handle the CD by its edges to avoid fingerprints on the playing surface.

- **Inspect the CD:** Briefly check the disc for any visible scratches, smudges, or debris on the shiny side.
- **Clean if necessary:** If smudges are present, gently wipe the disc from the center outwards with a soft, lint-free cloth. (Refer to the "Care and Maintenance" section for detailed cleaning instructions.)
- **Open Disc Tray:** Carefully open the disc tray of your CD player or computer.

Playing the Audio CD

Follow these steps to play your "Isolated" Audio CD:

1. **Insert the CD:** Place the CD into the disc tray with the label side facing up. Ensure it is seated correctly in the center spindle.
2. **Close Disc Tray:** Gently close the disc tray. Do not force it.
3. **Select Source:** On your audio system, select the CD input source.
4. **Press Play:** Press the "Play" button on your CD player or computer software to begin playback.
5. **Adjust Volume:** Adjust the volume to a comfortable listening level.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your "Isolated" Audio CD and ensure consistent audio quality.

Handling the CD

- Always hold the CD by its outer edge or by placing a finger through the center hole.
- Avoid touching the shiny, playable surface of the disc, as fingerprints and oils can degrade audio quality.
- Do not bend or flex the CD, as this can cause irreparable damage.

Cleaning the CD

If your CD has smudges or light dirt, follow these cleaning steps:

1. **Use a Soft Cloth:** Obtain a clean, soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., microfiber cloth).
2. **Dampen (Optional):** For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized CD cleaning solution. *Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents.*
3. **Wipe from Center Out:** Gently wipe the disc from the center hub outwards in straight lines. *Do not wipe in circular motions, as this can create circular scratches that are harder for the laser to read.*
4. **Dry Thoroughly:** Ensure the disc is completely dry before reinserting it into a player.

Storage

- Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use.
- Keep CDs away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on top of CD cases, which can cause cracking or damage to the disc inside.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

If you encounter problems playing your "Isolated" Audio CD, refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
CD skips or stutters during playback.	Dust, smudges, or minor scratches on the disc surface.	Clean the CD using a soft, lint-free cloth, wiping from the center outwards. Ensure the disc is dry.
CD does not play at all.	Disc inserted incorrectly, severe damage, or player issue.	Ensure the CD is inserted label-side up. Check for severe damage. Try the CD in another player to rule out player malfunction.
Sound quality is poor or distorted.	Dirty disc, faulty audio cables, or player settings.	Clean the CD. Check audio cable connections. Verify audio settings on your player/receiver.
