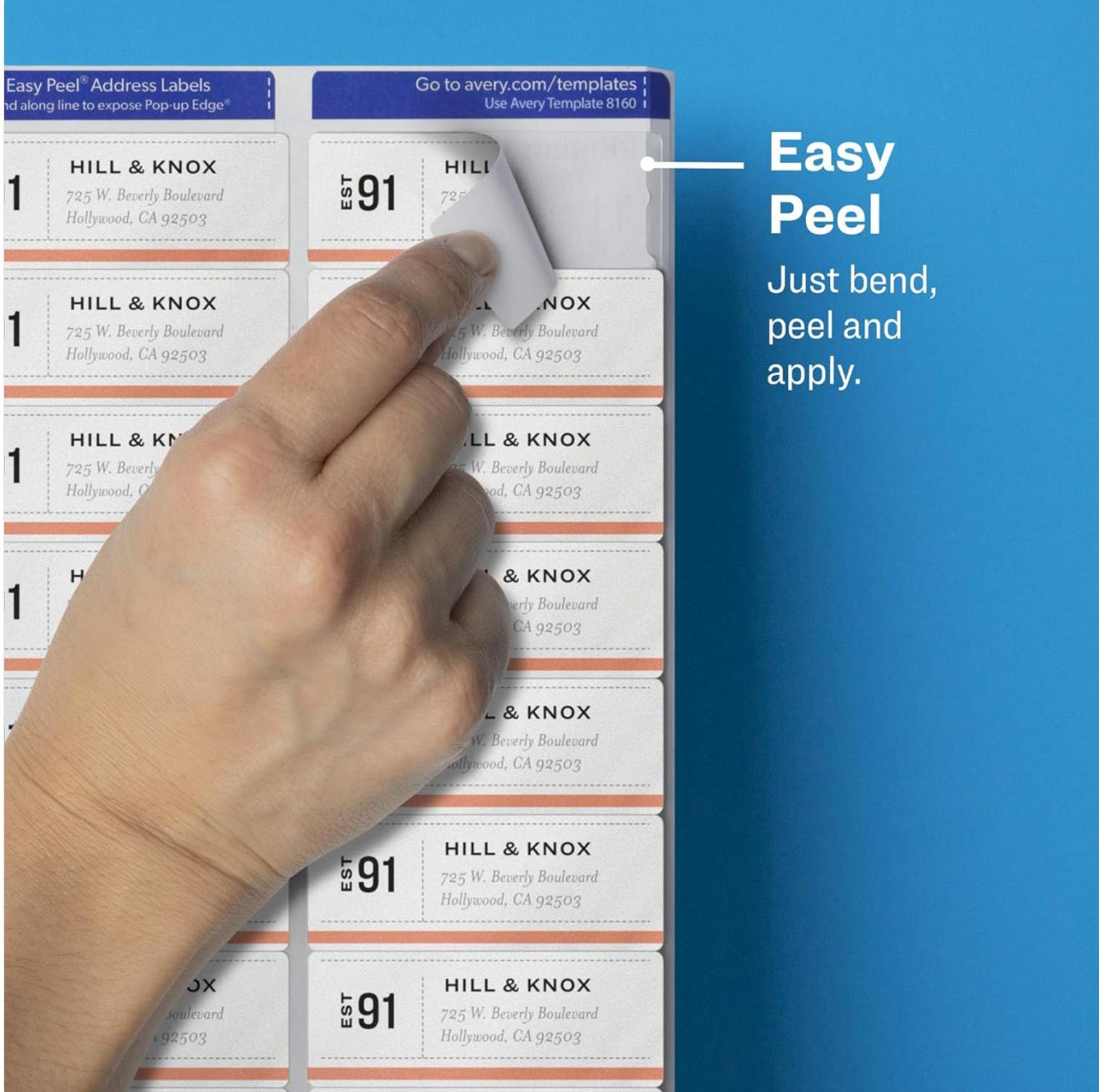
### Introduction

These matte clear labels, measuring 1" x 2-5/8", are designed for inkjet printers and come in packs of 750 labels (25 sheets of 30 labels each). They feature proprietary Sure Feed technology for reliable printing and Easy Peel with Pop-up Edge for convenient application.

### Setup

Before printing, ensure your printer is clean and properly configured for label printing. It is recommended to use Avery's free online templates for optimal results.

- 1. Access Templates:** Visit [avery.com/templates](http://avery.com/templates) to find the appropriate template for model 08660.
- 2. Design Your Labels:** Use the Avery Design & Print software to customize your labels with text, graphics, and mail merge data. No software download is required.
- 3. Printer Settings:** Adjust your printer settings to "Labels" or "Heavy Paper" for best feed and print quality. Ensure the paper size matches the label sheet (e.g., Letter 8.5" x 11").
- 4. Load Labels:** Load the label sheets into your inkjet printer's paper tray, ensuring they are oriented correctly according to your printer's instructions. The proprietary Sure Feed technology helps prevent misalignments and jams.

## Operating

Once your labels are designed and your printer is ready, proceed with printing and application.

- Print Labels:** Print a test sheet on plain paper first to check alignment. Once satisfied, print on the Avery label sheets. The Sure Feed technology is designed to provide a reliable feed through your inkjet printer, reducing misprints.
- Peel Labels:** Utilize the Easy Peel with Pop-up Edge feature. Gently bend the label sheet along the perforations to expose the edges of the labels, making them easier to peel.
- Apply Labels:** Carefully peel each label and apply it to your desired surface. The permanent adhesive ensures secure attachment to various materials, including envelopes, cardboard, plastic, metal, and glass.

### **Maintenance**

To ensure the longevity and quality of your Avery labels, proper storage is essential.

- **Storage:** Store unused label sheets in their original packaging in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. This helps prevent curling, discoloration, or adhesive degradation.
- **Handling:** Handle label sheets by the edges to avoid transferring oils or dirt from your hands onto the printable surface or adhesive.

## Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues while using your Avery labels, consider the following common solutions:

- **Misfeeds or Jams:**

- Ensure label sheets are loaded correctly and not bent or damaged.
- Check printer settings to ensure "Labels" or "Heavy Paper" is selected.
- Clean your printer's rollers if they appear dirty or are causing feeding issues.

- **Print Alignment Issues:**

- Always print a test sheet on plain paper first.
- Verify that you are using the correct Avery template for model 08660.
- Check your printer's margin settings and ensure they are not interfering with the print area.

- **Poor Print Quality:**

- Ensure your inkjet printer's ink cartridges are not low or clogged.
- Select a higher print quality setting in your printer preferences.
- Confirm the labels are designed for inkjet printers, as these are.

- **Labels Not Sticking:**

- Ensure the application surface is clean, dry, and free of dust or oils.
- Apply firm, even pressure across the entire label when adhering.
