INTRODUCTION

Driver 2 for PlayStation is an action-driving game where players assume the role of Tanner, an undercover police detective. The objective is to infiltrate criminal organizations and prevent an international mob war through a series of high-speed car chases and on-foot missions. The game features over 40 missions set across four distinct city environments. Key features include:

- Play as Tanner, a racecar driver-turned-police detective.
- Engage in vehicular pursuits across four different city settings.
- Experience action both behind the wheel and on foot, allowing for vehicle changes.
- Access one- and two-player minigames for extended play.
- Utilize the "Film director" option to review and edit car-chase sequences.

SETUP

To begin playing Driver 2, follow these steps:

1. Ensure your PlayStation console is powered off.
2. Open the disc tray of your PlayStation console.
3. Carefully place the Driver 2 game disc into the disc tray with the label facing up.
4. Close the disc tray.
5. Power on your PlayStation console.
6. Navigate the console's menu to select and launch the Driver 2 game.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Driver 2 gameplay primarily involves driving various vehicles and completing mission objectives. Players can also exit their vehicle to explore on foot and carjack other vehicles as needed.

Basic Controls (Standard PlayStation Controller)

- **Directional Pad/Analog Stick:** Steer vehicle / Move Tanner on foot.
- **X Button:** Accelerate vehicle / Run on foot.
- **Square Button:** Brake / Reverse vehicle / Jump on foot.
- **Triangle Button:** Enter/Exit vehicle / Action button.
- **Circle Button:** Handbrake.
- **L1/R1 Buttons:** Look left/right.
- **L2/R2 Buttons:** Change camera view.
- **Start Button:** Pause game / Access menu.

Familiarize yourself with these controls to effectively navigate the game's environments and complete missions.

GAME MODES

Driver 2 offers several modes of play:

- **Undercover Mode:** The main story mode, featuring over 40 missions across four cities. Progress through the narrative by completing objectives.
- **Take a Ride:** Explore the game's cities freely without mission constraints. This mode allows players to practice driving and discover hidden areas.
- **Minigames:** Engage in various one- and two-player minigames for competitive or cooperative play.
- **Film Director:** After completing missions or free-roaming, use this feature to replay and edit your gameplay sequences, creating custom car-chase videos.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing Driver 2, consider the following:

- **Mission Difficulty:** Some missions are designed to be challenging and may require multiple attempts. Experiment with different strategies and routes.
- **Graphical Performance:** The game may exhibit occasional slowdowns or object pop-in due to its original design and the hardware limitations of the PlayStation console. This is generally part of the game's intended experience.
- **Disc Read Errors:** If the game fails to load or freezes, inspect the game disc for scratches or smudges. Clean the disc gently with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Ensure the PlayStation console's lens is clean.
- **Controller Issues:** Verify your PlayStation controller is properly connected and functioning. Test it with other games if necessary.
