### Important Safety Information

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.

- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.

## Product Overview

The Presto Pizzazz Plus Rotating Oven is designed for convenient and efficient cooking of various foods, from frozen pizzas to homemade treats. Its unique design ensures even baking and energy efficiency.

### Key Features:

- **Rotating Tray:** Continuously turns to ensure even baking and consistent results.
- **Dual Heating Elements:** Independently controlled top and bottom heating elements allow you to select top, bottom, or both for customized cooking.
- **Integrated Timer:** Signals the end of cooking time and automatically turns off heating elements for safety and convenience.
- **Energy Efficient:** Saves up to 60% in energy compared to a conventional oven.
- **Easy Cleanup:** Features a removable nonstick baking pan for effortless cleaning and storage.

## Setup Instructions

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and any promotional labels from the oven.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wipe the nonstick baking pan and the exterior of the oven with a damp cloth. Ensure all parts are dry before assembly.
3. **Placement:** Place the oven on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls or cabinets to allow for proper ventilation. Ensure there is sufficient space around the unit.
4. **Insert Pan:** Place the removable nonstick baking pan onto the rotating base. Ensure it is seated correctly.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a 120-volt AC, 60 Hz electrical outlet. The rotating pan will begin to turn immediately upon plugging in, as there is no on/off switch for rotation.

## Operating Instructions

The Pizzazz Plus Rotating Oven does not require preheating, saving you time and energy. The cooking process begins as soon as the unit is plugged in and the timer is set.

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your food (e.g., pizza, chicken nuggets, egg rolls) directly onto the nonstick rotating pan.
2. **Select Heating Elements:** Use the control switches to select your desired heating configuration:
  - **LOWER:** Activates only the bottom heating element, ideal for crisping crusts.
  - **UPPER:** Activates only the top heating element, suitable for browning toppings.
  - **DUAL:** Activates both top and bottom heating elements for comprehensive cooking. This is the recommended setting for most foods.

3. **Set Timer:** Turn the timer knob clockwise to the desired cooking time. The timer can be set for up to 20 minutes. The heating elements will activate once the timer is set.
4. **Monitor Cooking:** The transparent viewing window allows you to observe the cooking progress without opening the lid.
5. **Completion:** When the timer reaches zero, it will signal with an audible alert and automatically turn off the heating elements. The rotating pan will continue to turn until the unit is unplugged.
6. **Remove Food:** Carefully remove the cooked food using appropriate utensils. The pan and heating elements will be hot.

### Cooking Tips:

- For **rising-crust pizza**, use the LOWER heating element for 10-12 minutes initially, then switch to DUAL for the remaining cooking time.
- For a **crisper crust**, bake with DUAL elements, then finish with a few minutes of LOWER-only heating.
- To give **toppings extra cooking time**, leave the UPPER element on for a little longer as needed.
- Cooking times may vary based on food type, thickness, and desired doneness. Adjust as necessary.

## Maintenance and Cleaning

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Pizzazz Plus Rotating Oven.

- 1. Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the oven from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning or storing.
- 2. Clean Baking Pan:** The removable nonstick baking pan is designed for easy cleaning. Wash it in warm, soapy water using a non-abrasive sponge or cloth. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Do not use metal scouring pads or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the nonstick coating.
- 3. Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the oven with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
- 4. Storage:** Store the oven in a dry place when not in use. The removable pan can be stored separately or on the unit once cool and clean.

## Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your Presto Pizzazz Plus Rotating Oven, please refer to the following common problems and solutions. For more complex issues, contact customer support.

- **Oven not turning on:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check if the circuit breaker has tripped.
- **Pan not rotating:** The rotating mechanism is activated upon plugging in the unit. If the pan does not rotate, ensure the pan is correctly seated on the base. If the issue persists, unplug the unit and contact customer service.
- **Food not cooking evenly:** Ensure the food is centered on the rotating pan. Verify that the selected heating elements (LOWER, UPPER, or DUAL) are appropriate for the food being cooked. Adjust cooking time as needed.
- **Food burning:** Reduce cooking time or adjust the heating element selection. For example, if the top is burning, switch to LOWER for a portion of the cooking time.
