## SETUP

---

### 1. System Requirements

- PlayStation 2 console
- PlayStation 2 compatible controller
- Memory Card (8MB) for PlayStation 2 (sold separately) for saving game progress

### 2. Installation

1. Ensure your PlayStation 2 console is powered off.
2. Insert the F1 2001 game disc into the disc tray of your PlayStation 2 console.

3. Close the disc tray.
4. Power on your PlayStation 2 console. The game should load automatically.
5. If the game does not load, navigate to the Browser menu on your PlayStation 2 and select the F1 2001 disc icon.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Game Modes

- **Championship:** Compete in a full Formula One season, aiming for the driver's and constructor's titles.
- **Single Race:** Select any track and car for a quick race.
- **Time Trial:** Practice your skills and set the fastest lap times on any circuit.
- **Challenge Mode:** Engage in specific scenarios and objectives to hone your racing abilities.

### 2. Basic Controls (Standard PlayStation 2 Controller)

Control	Function
Left Analog Stick / Directional Buttons	Steering (Left/Right)
X Button	Accelerate
Square Button	Brake / Reverse
R1 Button	Shift Up (Manual Transmission)
L1 Button	Shift Down (Manual Transmission)
Triangle Button	Change Camera View
Start Button	Pause Game / Access Menu
Select Button	Display Race Information / Map

*Note: Specific control configurations may vary and can often be customized within the game's options menu.*

### 3. Gameplay Features

- **Dynamic Weather:** Experience changing weather conditions that impact track grip and require strategic pit stops for tire changes.
- **Intelligent AI:** Opponent drivers react dynamically, battling for position and looking for overtaking opportunities.
- **Pit Stop Strategy:** Manage your pit stops effectively to gain an advantage. Your race engineer provides crucial updates and advice.
- **Car Setup:** Adjust various car settings in simulation mode to optimize performance for different tracks and conditions.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Disc Care

- Always hold the disc by its edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches.
- Store the disc in its original case when not in use to protect it from dust and damage.
- If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

- Avoid exposing the disc to direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Common Issues and Solutions

- **Game Does Not Load:**
  - Ensure the disc is clean and free of scratches.
  - Verify the disc is inserted correctly into the PlayStation 2 console.
  - Restart the PlayStation 2 console.
- **Freezing or Glitches:**
  - Clean the game disc thoroughly.
  - Ensure your PlayStation 2 console's ventilation is not blocked.
  - Try playing another game to determine if the issue is specific to F1 2001 or the console.
- **Controller Not Responding:**
  - Check that the controller is securely plugged into the correct port.
  - Test with another controller if available.
