


Image 1.1: Front cover of the Test Drive Off Road: Wide Open game for Xbox.

2. SETUP

2.1 System Requirements

- **Console:** Original Xbox system. This game is not compatible with Xbox 360 or newer consoles without specific backward compatibility updates, which are not available for this title.
- **Controller:** Standard Xbox controller.

- **Memory Unit:** An Xbox Memory Unit is recommended for saving game progress and settings.

2.2 Game Installation

1. Ensure your Xbox console is powered off.
2. Insert the Test Drive Off Road: Wide Open game disc into the Xbox disc tray.
3. Close the disc tray.
4. Power on your Xbox console. The game should automatically load.
5. Follow any on-screen prompts to create a save file on your Memory Unit or console hard drive.



3.4 Basic Controls (Standard Xbox Controller)

While specific in-game control mapping may vary or be customizable, the standard Xbox controller layout typically includes:

- **Left Analog Stick:** Steering
- **Right Analog Stick:** Camera control
- **A Button:** Accelerate

- **B Button:** Brake/Reverse
- **X Button:** Handbrake/Special Action
- **Y Button:** Change View
- **Left Trigger:** Brake
- **Right Trigger:** Accelerate
- **D-Pad:** Menu Navigation / Minor Adjustments
- **Start Button:** Pause Menu
- **Back Button:** Map / Information Screen

4. MAINTENANCE
