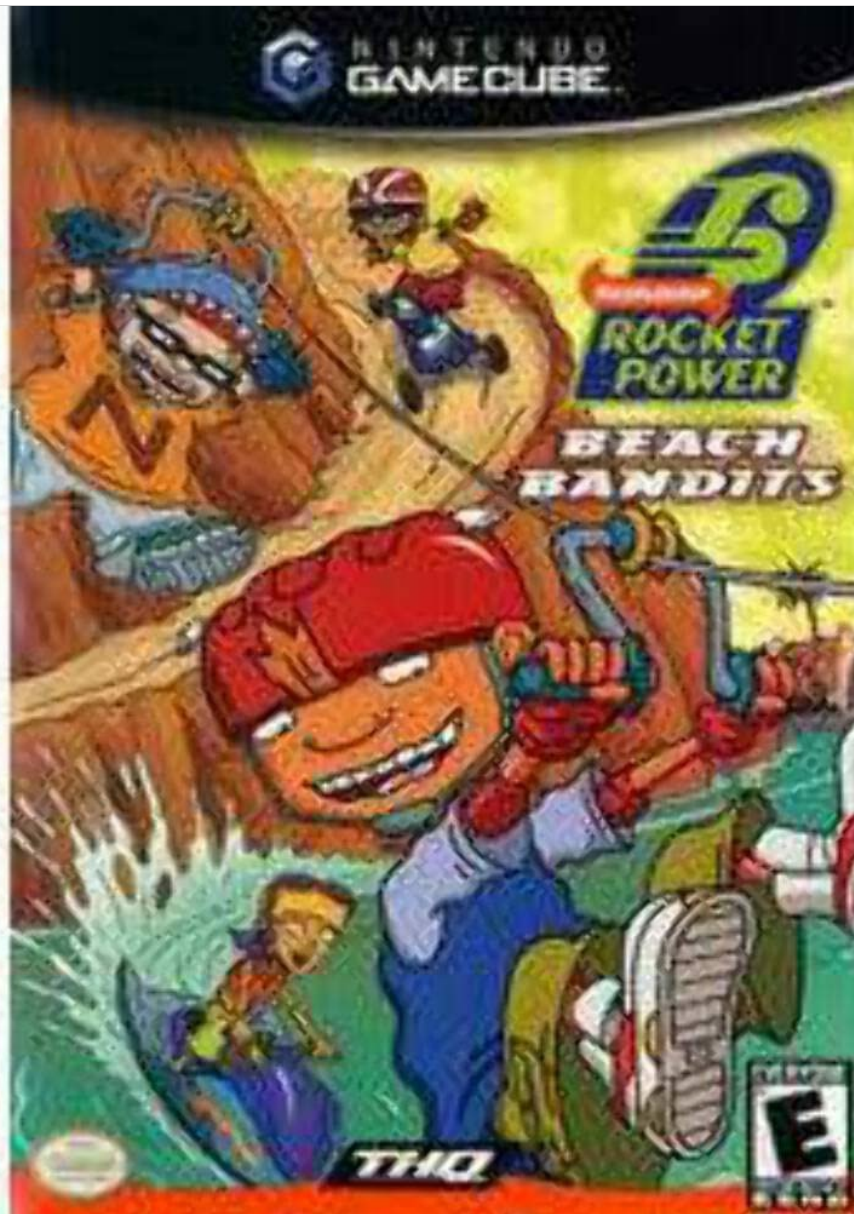

1. INTRODUCTION

Players will navigate through various environments, including Ocean Shores, the Lakes, the Robot Factory, and Mondo Mountain, to uncover the truth behind Mr. A.I. Golem's robotics company.

The game features over 50 levels of gameplay, incorporating extreme sports such as skateboarding, inline skating, wave runner action, and zip-line gliding. Your mission is to help the Rocket Power crew restore the beach and the surf contest.

2. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your game and begin playing:

1. **Connect Your Nintendo GameCube:** Ensure your Nintendo GameCube console is properly connected to your television and power source according to the console's instruction manual.
2. **Connect Controller(s):** Plug your GameCube controller(s) into the controller ports on the front of the console.
3. **Insert Game Disc:** Open the GameCube disc tray and carefully place the *Rocket Power Beach Bandits* game disc, label side up, onto the spindle. Close the disc tray securely.
4. **Power On:** Turn on your television and select the correct input channel. Then, press the POWER button on your Nintendo GameCube console. The game should load automatically.

- **Storage:** Store the disc in its original case when not in use to protect it from dust, scratches, and direct sunlight.

4.2 Console Care

- **Ventilation:** Ensure your GameCube console has adequate ventilation. Do not block air vents or place the console in an enclosed space.
- **Cleaning:** Keep the console free of dust by occasionally wiping its exterior with a soft, dry cloth.
- **Environment:** Operate the console in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures and humidity.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Audio/Video:**

- Confirm that your television is on the correct input channel.
- Check all audio/video cables connecting the GameCube to your television are securely connected.
- Ensure your TV's volume is not muted or set too low.
