INTRODUCTION TO SSX TRICKY

SSX Tricky is an extreme snowboarding video game developed by EA Canada and published by Electronic Arts. Released for the PlayStation 2, it is known for its fast-paced gameplay, exaggerated tricks, and vibrant characters. This manual provides essential information for setting up, playing, and maintaining your game.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Unpacking the Game

Carefully remove the game disc from its case. Ensure the disc surface is clean and free of scratches or debris before insertion.

2. Inserting the Game Disc

1. Power on your PlayStation 2 console.
2. Open the disc tray.
3. Hold the SSX Tricky game disc by its edges and gently place it onto the disc tray spindle, label side up.
4. Close the disc tray.

3. Starting the Game

Once the disc is inserted, the PlayStation 2 console should automatically detect the game and begin loading. If it does not, navigate to the "Browser" option on the PlayStation 2 main menu and select the disc icon to start SSX Tricky.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Controls (PlayStation 2 Controller)

- **Left Analog Stick:** Steer/Move Character
- **Right Analog Stick:** Camera Control
- **X Button:** Jump/Grab
- **Square Button:** Grind
- **Circle Button:** Boost/Tweak Grab
- **Triangle Button:** Reset to Course
- **L1/R1 Buttons:** Rotate/Spin

- **L2/R2 Buttons:** Grab Modifiers
- **Start Button:** Pause Menu
- **Select Button:** View Score/Leaderboard

Gameplay Modes

- **World Circuit:** Progress through various events, unlock characters, and upgrade stats.
- **Single Event:** Play individual races or show-off events on unlocked tracks.
- **Freeride:** Explore tracks without competition or time limits.

Performing Tricks

To perform tricks, press the Jump button (X) to launch into the air. While airborne, combine directional inputs with the Grab (X) and Grind (Square) buttons, along with L1/R1 for spins and L2/R2 for grab modifiers. Successfully landing tricks builds your boost meter. Performing "Uber Tricks" fills your Tricky meter, allowing for special moves.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Disc Handling and Storage

- Always hold the game disc by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole to avoid touching the data surface.
- Store the disc in its original case when not in use to protect it from dust, scratches, and direct sunlight.
- Avoid exposing the disc to extreme temperatures or humidity.

Cleaning the Disc

If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe the data side with a soft, lint-free cloth. Wipe from the center of the disc outwards in a straight line. Do not use abrasive cleaners or circular motions, as this can cause scratches. For stubborn smudges, a slightly damp cloth with water can be used, followed by immediate drying with a clean, dry cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Game does not load or freezes.	Disc is dirty or scratched; console lens is dirty; console malfunction.	Clean the game disc (see Maintenance). Try another game disc to check if the console is functioning correctly. If issues persist, consult your PlayStation 2 console manual or a qualified technician.
Graphics or sound issues.	Loose AV cables; disc issue; console settings.	Ensure all AV cables are securely connected to both the console and the television. Clean the game disc. Check your console's display and audio settings.
Controller not responding.	Controller not connected; faulty controller; port issue.	Ensure the controller is firmly plugged into the correct port. Try another controller if available. Test the controller in a different port or with another game.
