## DISC HANDLING AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your DVD, please follow these guidelines:

- **Hold the Disc Properly:** Always hold the DVD by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface to prevent fingerprints and scratches.
- **Store in Case:** When not in use, store the DVD in its original protective case to shield it from dust, scratches, and direct sunlight.
- **Keep Clean:** If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (such as a microfiber cloth) from the center outwards in a straight line. Do not wipe in circular motions. For stubborn smudges, a small amount of disc cleaning solution or water can be applied to the cloth, not directly to the disc.
- **Avoid Extreme Conditions:** Do not expose the DVD to extreme temperatures, high humidity, or direct sunlight for extended periods, as this can warp the disc and damage the data.
- **No Adhesives:** Do not attach labels, stickers, or any adhesive materials to the disc surface, as this can unbalance the disc and interfere with playback.

## PLAYBACK INSTRUCTIONS

This DVD is designed for playback on standard DVD players, Blu-ray players with DVD compatibility, and computer DVD-ROM drives. Ensure your player is compatible with NTSC format discs.

1. **Insert Disc:** Gently insert the DVD into your player's disc tray or slot, ensuring the label side is facing up.
2. **Power On:** Turn on your DVD player and television/monitor. Select the correct input source on your television.
3. **Menu Navigation:** Once the disc loads, the main menu should appear. Use your player's remote control (or keyboard/mouse for computers) to navigate through the menu options, such as "Play All," "Episode Selection," or "Scene Selection."
4. **Basic Controls:**
  - **Play/Pause:** Start or temporarily stop playback.
  - **Stop:** End playback and return to the beginning of the disc or menu.
  - **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Speed up or slow down playback.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Disc does not play or load.	<p>Ensure the disc is inserted correctly (label side up).</p> <p>Check for smudges or scratches on the disc surface and clean if necessary.</p> <p>Verify your DVD player is functioning correctly and is compatible with NTSC DVDs.</p> <p>Try playing another DVD to confirm the player is working.</p>
Video skips, freezes, or pixelates.	<p>Clean the disc thoroughly as described in the "Disc Handling and Care" section.</p> <p>Check for deep scratches that might be affecting playback.</p> <p>Ensure your DVD player's lens is clean (consult your player's manual for cleaning instructions).</p>

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No audio or distorted audio.	<p>Check the audio cables connecting your DVD player to your TV/receiver.</p> <p>Ensure the volume on your TV/receiver is turned up and not muted.</p> <p>Verify the audio settings on your DVD player.</p>
