INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Sony Handycam DCR-TRV33 MiniDV Camcorder. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the camcorder and retain it for future reference.

The Sony DCR-TRV33 is a MiniDV camcorder featuring a 10x optical zoom, a 3-inch touch-panel LCD, and the ability to capture 1 MP still images. It is designed for recording high-quality digital video and still photographs.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

Charging the Battery

Before initial use, fully charge the supplied battery pack.

1. Connect the AC adapter to the camcorder's DC IN jack.
2. Plug the AC adapter into a wall outlet.
3. The CHARGE lamp will light up during charging and turn off when charging is complete.

Inserting a MiniDV Cassette

1. Open the cassette compartment by sliding the OPEN/EJECT lever.
2. Insert a MiniDV cassette with the tape window facing outwards.
3. Close the cassette compartment until it clicks into place.

Inserting a Memory Stick (for Still Images)

1. Locate the Memory Stick slot, usually behind a small cover.
2. Insert the Memory Stick firmly until it clicks.
3. Close the cover.

OPERATING THE CAMCORDER

Power On/Off

To turn on the camcorder, slide the POWER switch to the CAMERA or VCR position. To turn off, slide it to OFF.

Recording Video

1. Set the POWER switch to CAMERA.
2. Open the LCD panel or pull out the viewfinder.
3. Point the camcorder at your subject.
4. Press the START/STOP button to begin recording. Press it again to stop.

Using the Zoom

Use the W (Wide) and T (Tele) buttons on the zoom lever to adjust the optical zoom.

Capturing Still Images

1. Ensure a Memory Stick is inserted.
2. Set the POWER switch to CAMERA.
3. Frame your shot using the LCD or viewfinder.
4. Press the PHOTO button to capture a still image.

Playback

1. Set the POWER switch to VCR.
2. Use the PLAY, REW, FF, PAUSE buttons on the touch-panel LCD or physical controls to navigate your recordings.
3. Connect the A/V cable to a TV for viewing on a larger screen.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Camcorder

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the camcorder. For the lens, use a lens cleaning cloth and solution specifically designed for optical lenses.

Battery Care

Store batteries in a cool, dry place. If not using the camcorder for an extended period, remove the battery.

Tape Head Cleaning

If video playback quality deteriorates (e.g., snowy picture), the tape heads may need cleaning. Use a dry-type MiniDV head cleaning cassette according to its instructions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Camcorder does not power on.	Ensure the battery is charged and properly inserted, or connect the AC adapter.
No image on LCD/viewfinder.	Check if the lens cap is removed. Ensure the camcorder is in CAMERA mode.
Poor video quality during playback.	Clean the tape heads using a cleaning cassette. Ensure the tape is not damaged.
Still images are blurry.	Ensure adequate lighting. Hold the camcorder steady when taking photos.
