PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GPX D715 is a versatile clock radio designed for convenience and functionality. It includes an AM/FM tuner, a top-loading CD player, a digital clock with a red LED display, and dual alarm capabilities. The unit is equipped with stereo full-range speakers for clear audio output and a battery backup system to maintain time and alarm settings during power outages.

SETUP

1. Power Connection

Plug the AC power cord into a standard wall outlet. The unit will power on, and the display will illuminate.

2. Battery Backup Installation

For uninterrupted timekeeping and alarm settings during power interruptions, install a 9V battery (not included) into the battery compartment located on the bottom of the unit. Ensure correct polarity (+/-) when inserting the battery.

3. Setting the Clock

1. Press and hold the **TIME SET** button. The hour digits on the display will begin to flash.
2. Press the **HOUR** button repeatedly to adjust the hour. Pay attention to the AM/PM indicator.
3. Press the **MINUTE** button repeatedly to adjust the minutes.
4. Press the **TIME SET** button again to confirm the time.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Radio Operation (AM/FM)

1. Press the **FUNCTION** button to select either FM or AM radio mode.
2. Extend the FM wire antenna for better FM reception. For AM, rotate the unit for optimal reception.
3. Use the **TUNING** knob or **TUNE +/-** buttons to manually tune to your desired station.
4. Adjust the volume using the **VOLUME** knob.

CD Player Operation

1. Open the CD compartment door located on top of the unit.
2. Place a CD with the label side facing up into the compartment. Close the door securely.
3. Press the **FUNCTION** button to select CD mode. The CD will begin to play automatically.
4. Use the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to pause or resume playback.
5. Press the **STOP** button to stop playback.
6. Use the **SKIP/SEARCH** buttons (**<<</>>>**) to skip tracks or search within a track.
7. **Programming Tracks:** While in STOP mode, press the **PROGRAM** button. Select desired tracks

using the **SKIP/SEARCH** buttons and press **PROGRAM** again to confirm each track. Up to 20 tracks can be programmed. Press **PLAY** to start programmed playback.

Setting Alarms (Dual Alarm)

The D715 features two independent alarms (Alarm 1 and Alarm 2).

1. Press and hold the **ALARM 1 SET** or **ALARM 2 SET** button. The hour digits for that alarm will flash.
2. Use the **HOUR** and **MINUTE** buttons to set the desired alarm time.
3. Press the **ALARM SET** button again to confirm the time.
4. Immediately after setting the time, press the **ALARM MODE** button (or similar, refer to unit's specific button) to cycle through wake options: **Buzzer**, **Radio**, or **CD**.
5. To activate/deactivate an alarm, press the respective **ALARM ON/OFF** button. An indicator will appear on the display when an alarm is active.
6. To temporarily silence an alarm, press the **SNOOZE** button. The alarm will sound again after approximately 9 minutes.
7. To turn off an alarm completely, press the **ALARM ON/OFF** button for the active alarm.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Unit

Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure the unit is unplugged before cleaning.

CD Player Care

Keep the CD compartment clean and free of dust. Avoid touching the CD lens. If the lens requires cleaning, use a specialized CD lens cleaner disc.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not securely plugged in.	Check power cord connection to outlet and unit.
Radio static/poor reception	Antenna not extended/positioned correctly. Interference from other electronics.	Extend and adjust FM wire antenna. Rotate unit for AM reception. Move unit away from other electronic devices.
CD not playing/skipping	CD is dirty, scratched, or inserted incorrectly. CD compartment door not closed.	Clean CD with a soft cloth. Ensure CD is inserted label-side up. Close CD compartment door completely. Try a different CD.
Alarm does not sound	Alarm not activated. Alarm volume too low.	Ensure alarm indicator is visible on display. Increase volume if waking to radio/CD.
Clock/alarm settings lost after power outage	9V backup battery is dead or not installed.	Install a fresh 9V battery or replace existing one.
