Introduction

Parts Identification

Your Fissler Magic Salt Mill consists of the following main components:

- **Main Body:** The stainless steel housing that holds the salt.
- **Grinding Mechanism:** The ceramic component located at the bottom, responsible for grinding.
- **Top Section/Cap:** The upper part that twists to operate the mill and allows access to the filling chamber.

Setup

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the salt mill from its packaging and dispose of all packing materials responsibly.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the mill according to the 'Maintenance and Cleaning' instructions. Ensure all parts are completely dry.
3. **Filling the Mill:**
 - Hold the main body firmly.
 - Twist the top section counter-clockwise to separate it from the main body.
 - Fill the transparent chamber with coarse salt. Do not overfill; leave a small gap at the top.
 - Reattach the top section by aligning it and twisting clockwise until it is securely fastened.

Operating Instructions

The Fissler Magic Salt Mill operates manually, providing fresh ground salt with a simple twist.

1. **Grinding Salt:** Hold the main body of the mill firmly with one hand. With the other hand, twist the top section clockwise. The ceramic grinding mechanism at the bottom will activate, dispensing ground salt.
2. **Grind Size Adjustment:** This model features a fixed grind setting for consistent results. No adjustment is required or possible.
3. **Storage:** Store the salt mill in a dry place when not in use to prevent moisture from affecting the salt or mechanism.

Maintenance and Cleaning

Proper care will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Fissler Magic Salt Mill.

- **Dishwasher Safe:** The Fissler Magic Salt Mill is dishwasher safe. For best results and to prolong the life of the ceramic grinding mechanism and stainless steel finish, hand washing is recommended.
- **Hand Washing:** To clean by hand, disassemble the mill by twisting the top section off. Wash both parts with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly under running water to remove all soap residue.
- **Drying:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling and refilling with salt. Moisture can cause salt to clump and affect the grinding mechanism.
- **Avoid Abrasives:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or scouring pads on the stainless steel finish, as this can scratch the surface.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your Fissler Magic Salt Mill, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Mill not grinding or grinding poorly:**
 - **Check Salt Level:** Ensure the mill is adequately filled with coarse salt.
 - **Secure Assembly:** Verify that the top and bottom sections are securely fastened.
 - **Moisture/Clumping:** If the salt is damp or clumping, empty the mill, dry the salt thoroughly (e.g., by spreading it on a tray), and then refill. Clean the grinding mechanism if necessary.
 - **Foreign Objects:** Inspect the grinding mechanism for any lodged foreign objects. Carefully remove them if found.

- **Grinding mechanism feels stiff:**

- Salt residue can build up over time. Disassemble and clean the grinding mechanism thoroughly as described in the 'Maintenance and Cleaning' section.
