Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Memorex Internal CDRW Drive, Model 32023257. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and longevity.

Setup

System Requirements

- **Operating System:** Windows 98SE, Windows ME, Windows 2000, Windows XP
- **Processor:** Minimum Pentium 166 MMX
- **RAM:** Minimum 64MB
- **Interface:** EIDE (PATA) compatible motherboard connection
- **Hardware Platform:** PC

Physical Installation

1. **Preparation:** Power off your computer and disconnect all cables. Open the computer case.
2. **Mounting:** Secure the Memorex CDRW drive into an available 5.25-inch drive bay.
3. **Connect Cables:**
 - Connect the EIDE ribbon cable from the motherboard to the drive. Ensure the red stripe on the cable aligns with Pin 1 on both the motherboard connector and the drive.
 - Connect a 4-pin power cable from the power supply unit to the drive.
 - (Optional) Connect an audio cable from the drive to your sound card if you intend to play audio CDs through your computer's speakers.
4. **Jumper Settings:** Configure the drive's master/slave/cable select jumpers according to your system's EIDE configuration. Refer to your computer's motherboard manual for specific instructions.
5. **Close Case:** Once all connections are secure, close your computer case and reconnect all external cables.

Software Installation

Upon first boot, your operating system may automatically detect and install basic drivers for the Memorex CDRW drive. For full functionality, including CD burning capabilities, install the software provided with your drive (e.g., Nero burning suite). Follow the on-screen instructions during the software installation process.

Operating Instructions

Basic Disc Handling

- **Inserting a Disc:** Press the eject button on the drive's front panel. Place the disc, label side up, into the tray. Gently push the tray back into the drive until it clicks shut.
- **Ejecting a Disc:** Press the eject button on the drive, or right-click the drive icon in "My Computer" (or "This PC") and select "Eject."

Creating and Managing Discs

The Memorex CDRW drive, combined with its accompanying software, allows for various disc creation and management tasks:

- **Making Music CDs:** Use the provided software to compile audio tracks (MP3, WAV, CD-DA) and burn them to a blank CD-R or CD-RW disc. This allows for custom mixes for personal use.
- **Creating Photo Albums:** Store digital photographs on CD-R or CD-RW discs. This provides a reliable and affordable method for archiving high-resolution image files.
- **Backup and Store Digital Files:** Utilize the drive to back up important documents, system files, and other data from your hard drive to CD-R or CD-RW media.
- **Copying CDs:** Duplicate existing CDs, including data, music, and application discs, onto blank recordable media.
- **Recording MP3s:** Directly record MP3 files to a CD. The included software supports "MP3 decoding-on-the-fly," reducing the need for temporary file transfers to the hard drive.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning Discs:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe discs from the center outwards. Avoid circular motions.
- **Drive Cleaning:** Periodically use a specialized CD/DVD drive cleaning disc to remove dust from the laser lens.
- **Physical Care:** Keep the drive tray free of obstructions. Avoid exposing the drive to excessive dust, moisture, or extreme temperatures.

Troubleshooting

- **Drive Not Detected:**
 - Check EIDE and power cable connections.
 - Verify jumper settings (Master/Slave/Cable Select).
 - Ensure the drive is enabled in the system's BIOS settings.
- **Disc Read Errors:**
 - Inspect the disc for scratches or dirt; clean if necessary.
 - Try a different disc to determine if the issue is with the disc or the drive.
 - Use a drive cleaning disc.
- **Burning Failures:**
 - Ensure you are using compatible blank media (CD-R or CD-RW).
 - Close other applications during the burning process to free up system resources.
 - Try burning at a lower speed.
 - Update your burning software to the latest version.





