## INTRODUCTION

---

## 1. SETUP

---

To begin enjoying your Seal IV Audio CD, follow these simple steps:

- **Cleaning:** If the disc is dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh chemicals. Specialized CD cleaning kits are recommended for stubborn smudges.
- **Storage:** Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Bending:** Do not bend the disc, as this can cause irreparable damage.

### 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Audio CD, consider the following solutions:

- **Disc Not Playing:**
  - Ensure the disc is inserted correctly (label side up).
  - Clean the disc surface as described in the Maintenance section.
  - Try playing the disc in a different CD player to rule out player issues.
- **Skipping or Stuttering:**
  - Clean the disc thoroughly. Minor scratches or dust can cause skipping.
  - Ensure the CD player is on a stable surface to prevent vibrations.
- **No Sound:**
  - Check the volume level on your player and connected audio system.
  - Verify that all audio cables are securely connected.
