1. Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the proper use, maintenance, and care of your Acme Kastmaster Lure with Buck Tail Teaser. Designed for versatility and durability, the Kastmaster lure is engineered to attract a wide range of fish species in both fresh and saltwater environments.

The Kastmaster's unique balance ensures wild action without line twist, making it an effective and reliable choice for anglers. Its aerodynamic design allows for exceptional casting distance.

2. Key Features

- Durable Construction:** Machined from solid brass, ensuring it will not break, bend, or corrode. It retains its luster even after repeated exposure to saltwater.
- Versatile Application:** Ideal for catching trout, pickerel, panfish, smallmouth bass, and snapperblues. Effective in both fresh and saltwater.
- Optimal Performance:** Designed for use with 2-4 lb test lines, suitable for ultra-lite, light spinning, and ice jigging techniques.
- Aerodynamic Design:** Facilitates long and accurate casts.
- Buck Tail Teaser:** Enhances attraction and mimics natural prey movement.

3. Setup and Rigging

Proper rigging is crucial for the Kastmaster lure's optimal performance. Follow these steps to prepare your lure for fishing:

- Line Selection:** Use a fishing line with a test strength of 2-4 lbs for best results, especially for ultra-lite or light spinning setups.
- Knot Tying:** Securely tie your fishing line to the split ring at the front of the Kastmaster lure. A Palomar knot or an improved clinch knot are recommended for their strength and reliability. Ensure the knot is tight and trim any excess line.
- Leader (Optional):** For species with sharp teeth or in clear water conditions, consider using a

fluorocarbon or monofilament leader. Attach the leader to your main line using a strong knot (e.g., double uni knot) and then to the lure.

4. **Check Connections:** Before casting, always double-check all knots and connections to ensure they are secure.

4. Operating Instructions (Fishing Techniques)

The Kastmaster lure is highly versatile and can be used with various retrieval techniques to mimic different prey movements. Experiment to find what works best for your target species and fishing conditions.

- **Casting:** Due to its aerodynamic design, the Kastmaster is an excellent distance caster. Aim for areas where fish are likely to be, such as near structures, drop-offs, or schooling baitfish.
- **Retrieve Methods:**
 - **Steady Retrieve:** A consistent, medium-speed retrieve will cause the lure to wobble and flash, attracting predatory fish.
 - **Stop-and-Go:** Retrieve the lure for a few seconds, then pause, allowing it to flutter downwards. This often triggers strikes from hesitant fish.
 - **Jigging:** For deeper water or ice fishing, drop the lure to the desired depth and use short, sharp upward jerks of the rod tip, allowing the lure to fall on slack line.
 - **Twitching:** Incorporate small, erratic twitches of the rod tip during retrieval to create a more injured baitfish action.

- **Varying Depth:** Adjust your retrieve speed and allow time for the lure to sink to target different depths where fish may be holding.

5. Maintenance and Care

To ensure the longevity and continued effectiveness of your Acme Kastmaster Lure, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Rinse After Use:** After each fishing trip, especially in saltwater, rinse the lure thoroughly with fresh water to remove salt, dirt, and debris.
- **Dry Completely:** Allow the lure to air dry completely before storing to prevent corrosion and mildew on the buck tail.
- **Hook Inspection:** Regularly inspect the treble hook for sharpness and rust. Sharpen dull hooks with a hook file or replace rusted hooks to ensure effective hook sets.
- **Storage:** Store the lure in a tackle box or container that allows for air circulation. Avoid storing it with other lures that might cause tangles or damage to the buck tail.

- **Buck Tail Care:** If the buck tail becomes matted or dirty, gently rinse it and allow it to air dry. Avoid harsh chemicals.

6. Troubleshooting

While the Kastmaster lure is designed for reliability, minor issues can sometimes occur. Here are some common problems and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lure not wobbling correctly	Bent split ring or hook; line twist; improper retrieve speed.	Check and straighten split ring/hook. Use a swivel to prevent line twist. Adjust retrieve speed.
Buck tail matted or damaged	Improper storage; prolonged use; contact with sharp objects.	Gently rinse and air dry. Store separately. If severely damaged, consider replacing the hook.
Hooks becoming dull or rusty	Normal wear and tear; exposure to elements without proper rinsing.	Sharpen hooks with a hook file. Replace hooks if rust is severe or integrity is compromised.


