De'Longhi Perfecto Indoor Grill BG24 Instruction Manual

Model: BG24

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The De'Longhi Perfecto Indoor Grill BG24 is designed for healthy indoor grilling. It features a die-cast aluminum non-stick cooking surface with an embedded heating element and a special M-shaped grill design to ensure consistent heat distribution across the entire surface. The adjustable, detachable thermostat offers five temperature levels for precise cooking control. A non-stick splatter shield and tempered glass lid help contain mess and retain moisture, while cool-touch handles ensure safe operation. An indicator light signals when the grill is heating up.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Even Heat Distribution:** Fully embedded grill plate heating element and M-shaped design for consistent results.
- **Moisture Retention:** Tempered glass lid helps keep food juicy and can keep grilled food warm.
- **Large Cooking Surface:** Ample space to prepare meals for the entire family.
- **Adjustable Thermostat:** Detachable thermostat with five temperature levels for personalized grilling.
- **Easy Cleaning:** Non-stick grill plate and removable non-stick drip tray simplify cleanup.
- **Safety Features:** Cool-touch handles and an indicator light for safe operation.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Ensure all items are present upon unpacking:

- De'Longhi Perfecto BG24 Indoor Grill
- Tempered Glass Lid
- Instruction Manual

4. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons.

- **Read All Instructions:** Familiarize yourself with the entire manual before operation.
- **Hot Surfaces:** The grill plate and lid become very hot during use. Use cool-touch handles and oven mitts as needed.
- **Electrical Safety:** Do not immerse the thermostat or electrical components in water. Ensure hands are dry when plugging/unplugging.
- **Ventilation:** Use in a well-ventilated area.
- **Non-Stick Coating:** Avoid using metal utensils on the non-stick surface to prevent damage. Use wooden or heat-resistant plastic utensils.
- **Children:** Keep the appliance out of reach of children.

5. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the grill plate, drip tray, and tempered glass lid with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
3. **Assemble:** Place the drip tray into the base of the grill. Ensure it is properly seated.
4. **Install Grill Plate:** Position the non-stick grill plate securely over the heating element.
5. **Attach Thermostat:** Insert the detachable thermostat into the designated slot on the side of the grill plate. Ensure it clicks firmly into place.
6. **Add Water to Drip Tray:** Fill the removable drip tray with water up to the indicated maximum level. This helps reduce smoke and keeps food moist.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Plug In:** Plug the power cord into a standard 120V electrical outlet.
- 2. Preheat:** Turn the adjustable thermostat to your desired temperature setting. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the grill is heating. Allow 3-4 minutes for the grill to preheat. The indicator light will turn off when the desired temperature is reached.
- 3. Place Food:** Carefully place food directly onto the preheated non-stick grill plate.
- 4. Use Lid:** For juicier results and to reduce splatter, place the tempered glass lid over the grill while cooking.
- 5. Monitor Cooking:** Adjust the thermostat as needed during cooking.
- 6. Remove Food:** Once cooked, carefully remove food using wooden or heat-resistant plastic utensils.
- 7. Turn Off:** After use, turn the thermostat to the 'OFF' position and unplug the appliance.

7. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the grill and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Remove Thermostat:** Detach the adjustable thermostat. Do not immerse the thermostat in water.
- Empty Drip Tray:** Carefully remove and empty the non-stick drip tray. The drip tray is machine cleanable.
- Clean Grill Plate:** Wipe the non-stick grill plate with a soft, damp cloth or sponge. For stubborn residue, use a mild dish soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could damage the non-stick coating.
- Clean Lid:** The tempered glass lid can be washed with warm, soapy water or placed in the dishwasher.
- Clean Base:** Wipe the exterior of the grill base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base in water.
- Storage:** Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing the grill in a cool, dry place.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Grill Not Heating:** Ensure the thermostat is correctly inserted and plugged into a working outlet. Check that the thermostat is turned to an 'ON' position.
- Excessive Smoke:** Ensure the drip tray contains water. Excessive fat in the drip tray can also cause smoke; empty and refill with water if necessary.
- Food Sticking:** Ensure the grill plate is properly seasoned before use. Use a small amount of cooking oil or spray if needed. Avoid using metal utensils that can scratch the non-stick surface.
