1. INTRODUCTION

The Lite-On LVW-5005 AllWrite DVD/CD Recorder is a versatile device designed to simplify your digital content management. It supports recording to a wide array of optical media, including DVD+R/RW, DVD-R/RW, and CD-R/RW discs, offering comprehensive compatibility for your video and audio recording needs. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your LVW-5005 recorder.

Key Features:

- AllWrite DVD/CD recorder handles DVD-R/-RW, DVD+R/+RW, and CD-R/-RW optical media; writes to DVD+VR-mode DVD and VCD/SVCD.
- Records up to 6 hours on a single-sided 4.7 GB disc.
- Built-in NTSC tuner for direct recording of TV programs to long-life recordable DVD, including advance-programming options.
- Convenient one-touch recording for archiving and preserving home videos.
- Equipped with analog and digital video inputs and MCTF (motion-compensated temporal filtering) video noise reduction.
- Playback features include MP3 CD and JPEG digital image CD.
- Progressive-scan video outputs for high-definition and HD-ready TVs.
- Editing features: title edit, title naming, title protect, title overwrite, and title erase.
- Front-panel DV Link (IEEE 1394) input for digital camcorder footage transfer.

2. SETUP

Unpacking the Box:

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all items are present before discarding packing materials.

- DVD player/recorder unit (LVW-5005)
- Remote control
- Remote batteries (2 AA)
- User's manual
- AC power cord
- Stereo analog audio interconnect/composite-video cable
- RF coaxial AV cable

Connecting the Recorder:

The LVW-5005 offers various input and output options for connecting to your television, audio system, and other video sources. Refer to the diagram below for common connection points.

- **Video Outputs:** Connect to your TV using composite-video, S-video, or component-video (480i/480p progressive scan) for optimal picture quality.
- **Audio Outputs:** Use stereo analog audio outputs for standard audio connection, or digital audio (coaxial/optical) for surround sound receivers.
- **Video Inputs:** Connect external sources like VCRs, camcorders, or cable boxes using composite-video, S-video, or the front-panel IEEE 1394 (DV Link) input for digital camcorders.
- **Antenna/Cable Input:** Connect your antenna or cable TV signal to the RF coaxial input for recording TV programs.

3. OPERATION

Basic Playback:

Insert a disc into the disc tray. The recorder will automatically detect the disc type (DVD-Video, Audio CD, MP3 CD, JPEG CD, etc.) and begin playback or display a menu. Use the remote control for navigation and playback functions.






Recording:

The LVW-5005 supports recording from its built-in tuner or external sources. Ensure your input source is correctly connected and selected. For recording, you will need a blank recordable DVD (DVD+R/RW or DVD-R/RW) or CD (CD-R/RW).

- **One-Touch Recording:** Press the RECORD button on the unit or remote to start recording immediately from the selected input.
- **Scheduled Recording:** Utilize the on-screen menu to program recordings from the NTSC tuner at specific times.
- **Disc Preparation:** Before recording, blank rewritable media (DVD-RW, DVD+RW, CD-RW) may require
