1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

The Gardena Combisystem 59-Inch Aluminum Garden Tool Handle (Model 3715-20) is designed for use with various Gardena Combisystem tool heads. This lightweight yet sturdy aluminum handle provides a comfortable and non-slip grip, making gardening tasks easier and more efficient. It is an essential component for expanding your Gardena Combisystem tool collection.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This handle is designed for quick and secure attachment of Gardena Combisystem tool heads (sold separately). Follow these steps to attach a tool head:

1. **Select a Compatible Tool Head:** Ensure your chosen Gardena Combisystem tool head is compatible with the handle.
2. **Align and Insert:** Align the tool head's connector with the handle's end. Gently push the tool head onto the handle.
3. **Secure the Connection:** Once the tool head is fully inserted, tighten the orange screw mechanism on the handle to secure the tool head firmly in place. Do not overtighten, but ensure there is no wobble.

Note: If you experience difficulty inserting or removing a tool head, ensure proper alignment and avoid excessive force. If a tool head does not fit or becomes stuck, verify its compatibility with the Combisystem handle.




Image 2.1: Demonstrating the attachment of a Combisystem tool head to the handle.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once a tool head is securely attached, the handle is ready for use. The 59-inch length provides extended reach and leverage for various gardening tasks, reducing strain on your back.

- **Ergonomic Grip:** The grooved plastic coating ensures a comfortable and non-slip grip, even during prolonged use or in damp conditions.
- **Versatility:** This handle can be used with a wide range of Gardena Combisystem tools, including rakes, cultivators, hoes, and more, adapting to different gardening needs.
- **Proper Posture:** Always maintain good posture while gardening to prevent injury. The handle's length is designed to assist in this.

4. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Gardena Combisystem handle, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, wipe the handle clean with a damp cloth to remove soil, debris, and moisture. For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by rinsing and thorough drying.
- **Storage:** Store the handle in a dry, protected area away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Hanging the handle on a tool rack can help prevent damage and keep your workspace organized.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the handle for any signs of wear, damage, or loose components. Ensure the screw mechanism for attaching tool heads is functioning correctly.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Gardena Combisystem handle, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Tool Head Not Attaching Securely:**
 - Ensure the tool head is fully inserted into the handle.
 - Tighten the orange screw mechanism firmly.
 - Verify that both the handle and the tool head are genuine Gardena Combisystem products and are compatible.

- **Difficulty Removing Tool Head:**

- Loosen the orange screw mechanism completely.
- Apply gentle, steady pressure to pull the tool head straight off the handle. Avoid twisting or prying forcefully.
- If stuck, ensure no debris is obstructing the connection.

- **Handle Feels Loose or Wobbly:**

- Check the connection point for any damage or wear.
- Ensure the tool head is properly seated and the screw mechanism is tightened.
