Hasbro Duel Masters Monopoly Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for setting up and playing the Hasbro Duel Masters Monopoly board game. This special edition combines the classic property-trading gameplay of Monopoly with elements from the Duel Masters universe, allowing players to collect creatures and spells from five civilizations. The objective remains to become the wealthiest player by buying, renting, and trading properties.

GAME COMPONENTS

Before starting, ensure all the following components are present in your game box:

- 1 Game Board
- 28 Title Deed Cards (representing creatures and spells)
- 16 Creature Cards
- 16 Spell Cards
- 6 Duel Master Character Tokens
- 1 Pack of Duel Master Themed Money
- 32 Card Shops (representing houses)
- 12 Duelist Centers (representing hotels)
- 2 Dice
- 1 Instruction Booklet (this manual provides a summary, refer to the physical booklet for comprehensive rules)

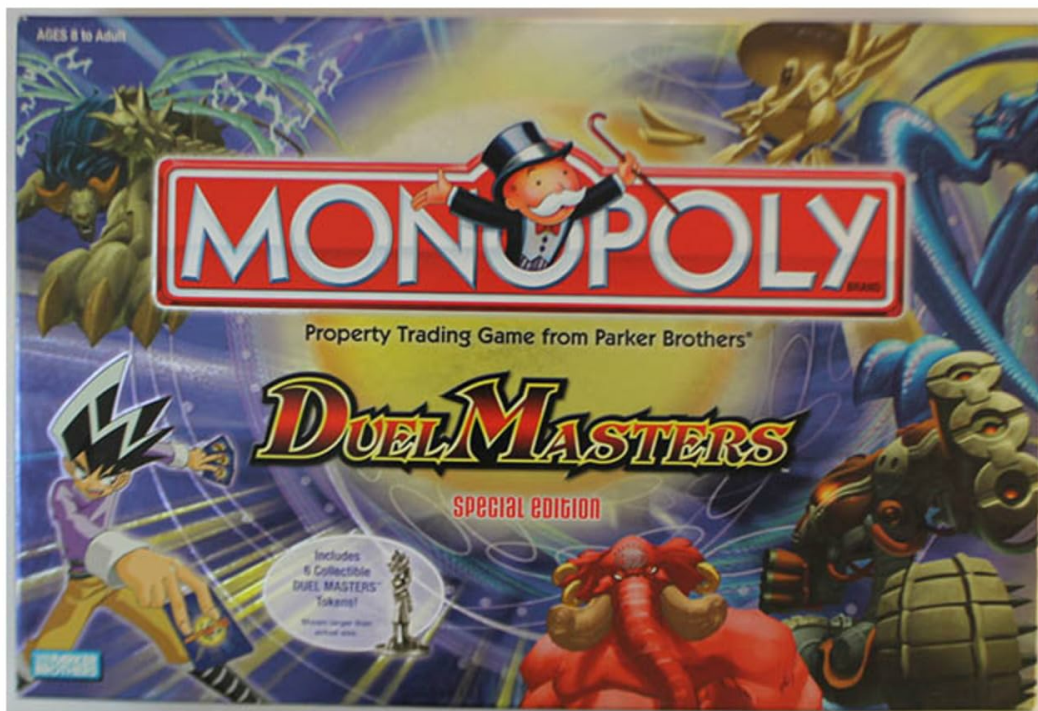

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Duel Masters Monopoly game:

1. **Unfold the Game Board:** Place the game board on a flat surface.
2. **Place Cards:** Shuffle the Creature cards and Spell cards separately and place them face down on their designated spaces on the board.
3. **Select Tokens:** Each player chooses one of the 6 Duel Master character tokens to represent them on the board.
4. **Choose a Banker:** One player is designated as the Banker. The Banker is responsible for all money transactions, including distributing starting money, collecting taxes, and managing the bank's funds. The Banker may also play, but must keep their personal funds separate from the bank's.
5. **Distribute Money:** The Banker gives each player their starting amount of Duel Master themed money. Refer to the physical instruction booklet for the exact starting amount.
6. **Prepare Properties:** Separate the Title Deed cards by color group and place them next to the board. Place the Card Shops and Duelist Centers in a general supply area.

7. **Starting Position:** Each player places their token on the 'GO' space.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS: STANDARD MONOPOLY GAMEPLAY

The game proceeds in turns, with players rolling dice and moving their tokens around the board. The primary goal is to acquire properties (Creatures and Spells), build Card Shops and Duelist Centers on them, and collect rent from other players who land on your properties, ultimately driving opponents into bankruptcy.

Player Turn Sequence:

1. **Roll the Dice:** The player whose turn it is rolls both dice.
2. **Move Token:** Move your token clockwise around the board the number of spaces indicated by the dice.
3. **Action on Space:** The action you take depends on the space your token lands on:
 - **Unowned Property (Creature/Spell):** You may buy the property from the Bank for the price printed on that space. If you choose not to buy it, the Banker immediately auctions it to the highest bidder.
 - **Owned Property:** If another player owns the property, you must pay them rent as indicated on their Title Deed card.
 - **Creature or Spell Card Space:** Draw the top card from the respective deck and follow its instructions.
 - **Go:** If you pass or land on 'GO', collect \$200 from the Bank.
 - **Income Tax/Luxury Tax:** Pay the specified amount to the Bank.
 - **Free Parking:** No action is required.
 - **Just Visiting/Jail:** If you land on 'Just Visiting', you are safe. If you land on 'Go to Jail', move your token directly to the 'In Jail' space.
4. **Doubles:** If you roll doubles, you take your turn as usual, then roll the dice again for another turn. If you roll doubles three times in a row, you immediately go to Jail.
5. **Building:** Once you own all properties in a color group, you can begin building Card Shops and then Duelist Centers on them during your turn. Buildings must be erected evenly across properties in a group.
6. **Trading:** Players can trade properties, money, and 'Get Out of Jail Free' cards with each other at any time.

Special Duel Masters Gameplay

The Duel Masters Monopoly edition includes special gameplay elements that integrate the Duel Masters theme beyond just property names. These special rules add an additional layer of strategy and excitement. For detailed rules on these unique features and how they interact with standard Monopoly gameplay, please refer to the dedicated instruction booklet included in your game box.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity of your Duel Masters Monopoly game:

- **Storage:** Always store all game components in their original box when not in use. Ensure all cards, money, and tokens are neatly organized to prevent loss or damage.
- **Environment:** Keep the game away from direct sunlight, moisture, and extreme temperatures, which can cause warping of the board or fading of components.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe the game board and plastic pieces if they become dusty. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
