1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Wear Eye Protection: Always wear appropriate eye protection to shield against flying debris.
- Secure Workpiece: Ensure the workpiece is stable and properly secured before applying clamping pressure.
- **Keep Hands Clear:** Do not place hands or fingers between the clamping jaws during operation to avoid pinching.
- **Inspect Before Use:** Before each use, inspect the clamp for any signs of damage or wear. Do not use a damaged clamp.
- Proper Use: Use the clamp only for its intended purpose of clamping and spreading workpieces.

3. SETUP

The wolfcraft EHZ 6-150 One-Hand Clamp PRO is ready for use directly out of the packaging. No assembly is required.

Initial Inspection:

- 1. Remove the clamp from its packaging.
- 2. Check all parts for any visible damage or defects.
- 3. Familiarize yourself with the clamping and release mechanisms by gently squeezing the trigger and pressing the release lever.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Clamping a Workpiece

- 1. Position the workpiece securely on a stable surface.
- 2. Open the clamp jaws by pressing the yellow release lever and sliding the movable jaw along the rail until it is wider than the workpiece.
- 3. Place the clamp over the workpiece, ensuring both jaws make full contact.
- 4. Squeeze the main trigger handle repeatedly until the clamp jaws firmly grip the workpiece. The clamping pressure will increase with each squeeze.
- 5. Ensure the workpiece is held securely before proceeding with your task.

4.3. Converting to Spreading Function

The clamp can be easily converted into a spreading tool:

- 1. Ensure the clamp is fully open and not under pressure.
- 2. Locate the button on the movable jaw mechanism.
- 3. Press this button and slide the movable jaw off the rail.
- 4. Re-attach the movable jaw to the opposite end of the rail, facing outwards.
- 5. The clamp is now configured for spreading. Squeeze the trigger to expand the jaws.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your wolfcraft One-Hand Clamp PRO.

- Cleaning: After each use, wipe down the clamp with a clean, dry cloth to remove dust, sawdust, and debris.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a light coat of machine oil to the rail and moving parts to ensure smooth operation. Avoid over-lubrication.
- Storage: Store the clamp in a dry environment to prevent rust and corrosion. Keep it away from extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check for loose screws, worn parts, or any damage. Tighten screws as needed. Replace any damaged components immediately.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Clamp not holding pressure: Check if the jaws are clean and free of debris. Ensure the workpiece surface is not excessively slippery. Inspect the trigger mechanism for any obstructions.
- Jaws not moving smoothly: Clean the rail and apply a small amount of lubricant. Check for any bent or damaged parts that might impede movement.
- **Difficulty converting to spreading function:** Ensure the clamp is fully open and not under tension. Press the release button firmly when attempting to remove or re-position the movable jaw.
