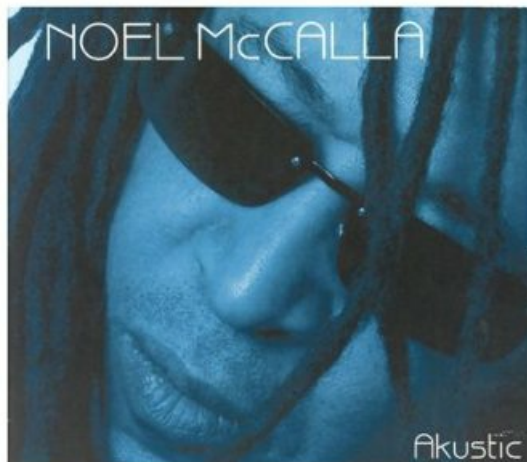

INTRODUCTION

SETUP

MAINTENANCE

- **Handling:** Always hold the CD by its outer edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playing surface.
- **Cleaning:** If the CD becomes dirty or smudged, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., microfiber) in a straight line from the center to the outer edge. Do not wipe in a circular motion. For stubborn dirt, use a specialized CD cleaning solution or a small amount of water.

- **Storage:** Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Be careful not to drop the CD or place it on rough surfaces, as scratches can affect playback quality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Akustic Audio CD, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
CD skips or stutters during playback.	Dirt, dust, or scratches on the disc surface.	Clean the CD carefully as described in the Maintenance section. Inspect for deep scratches. If heavily scratched, the disc may be permanently damaged.
CD does not play or is not recognized.	CD inserted incorrectly; CD player malfunction; disc is severely damaged.	Ensure the CD is inserted label-side up. Try the CD in another player to rule out player issues. Check for visible damage on the disc.
Poor sound quality (e.g., muffled, distorted).	Dirty disc; faulty audio cables/connections (if applicable to player); player issues.	Clean the CD. Check all audio connections from your CD player to your amplifier/speakers. Test with another CD to see if the problem persists.
