# Kirby and The Amazing Mirror

Official Instruction Manual for Game Boy Advance

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Mirror World! In **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror**, an evil shadow has invaded the Mirror World, and it's up to Kirby to save the day. This time, Kirby won't be alone. He has been split into four Kirbys of different colors, and with his trusty cell phone, he can call upon his colorful alter egos for assistance.

This game is designed exclusively for the **Game Boy Advance** system and is not compatible with other Game Boy systems.

## Key Features:

- **Four Kirbys:** Players can call in Red, Yellow, and Green Kirby to assist in solving puzzles, fighting enemies, and defeating bosses.
- **New Copy Abilities:** The game introduces new Copy Abilities, such as Cupid Kirby (arrow-shooting) and Smash Kirby (melee combat), alongside returning classic abilities.
- **Sub-Games:** Engage in various sub-games, including Crackity Hack and Kirby's Wave Ride, available for single-player or up to four players.
- **Multiplayer Action:** Play solo or link up with friends for cooperative multiplayer fun. Note: Multiplayer games require one Game Pak per player and a Game Boy Advance Game Link® cable, sold separately.

## 2. SETUP

To begin playing **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror**, follow these simple steps:

1. Ensure your Game Boy Advance system is powered off.
2. Insert the **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror** Game Pak firmly into the Game Pak slot on your Game Boy Advance.
3. Power on your Game Boy Advance system.
4. The game should start automatically. If it does not, ensure the Game Pak is fully inserted and try again.

### Multiplayer Setup:

For multiplayer gameplay, each player will need their own Game Boy Advance system and a copy of **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror**. Connect the systems using a Game Boy Advance Game Link® cable (sold separately). Follow the in-game instructions to initiate multiplayer sessions.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Basic Controls:

Button	Function
Directional Pad (D-Pad)	Move Kirby left/right, navigate menus.
A Button	Jump, confirm selections.
B Button	Inhale/Exhale, use Copy Ability, cancel selections.
L/R Buttons	Use the cell phone to call other Kirbys.
Start Button	Pause game, open menu.
Select Button	Access map or other special functions.

### Gameplay Mechanics:

- **Inhaling and Copying:** Inhale enemies by pressing the B button. Some enemies can be swallowed to copy their abilities.
- **Calling Other Kirbys:** Use the L or R button to call your other colorful Kirby clones for assistance in battles or to solve puzzles.
- **Exploring the Mirror World:** The game features a vast, interconnected world. Explore different areas to find secrets and progress through the story.
- **Sub-Games:** Access various sub-games for a quick break from the main adventure.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care of your **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror** Game Pak will ensure its longevity and optimal performance.

- Keep the Game Pak clean and free from dust and dirt. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the cartridge.
- Avoid touching the connector pins on the bottom of the Game Pak.
- Do not expose the Game Pak to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or moisture.
- Store the Game Pak in its original case or a protective storage case when not in use.
- Do not attempt to open or modify the Game Pak.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues while playing **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror**, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Game Not Starting:**
  - Ensure the Game Pak is fully and correctly inserted into the Game Boy Advance slot.
  - Clean the connector pins on the Game Pak with a cotton swab and rubbing alcohol, then allow to dry completely.
  - Check if your Game Boy Advance system has sufficient battery power.
- **Game Freezes or Crashes:**

- Turn off your Game Boy Advance, remove the Game Pak, reinsert it, and restart the system.
- Ensure the Game Pak is clean and free from damage.

- **Multiplayer Connection Issues:**

- Verify that the Game Boy Advance Game Link® cable is securely connected to all systems.
- Ensure all Game Boy Advance systems are powered on and have sufficient battery power.
- Confirm that all players have a copy of **Kirby and The Amazing Mirror**.
