1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Bahco Ergo Pocket Scraper is a robust tool designed for heavy-duty applications and precision scraping tasks. It features a durable carbide blade, making it suitable for removing various materials from different surfaces.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Ergonomic Design:** Engineered for maximum comfort and reduced effort during prolonged use.

3. SETUP

The Bahco Ergo Pocket Scraper comes pre-assembled with a 1-inch triangular carbide blade. No initial assembly is required for immediate use.

3.1 Blade Inspection

Before each use, inspect the carbide blade for any signs of damage or excessive wear. A sharp, intact blade ensures optimal performance and safety.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The scraper is designed for effective material removal. Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as safety glasses and gloves, when operating the tool.

4.1 General Scraping

1. Grip the two-component handle firmly.
2. Position the carbide blade at a shallow angle against the surface to be scraped.
3. Apply steady, even pressure and pull the scraper towards you to remove material. Avoid pushing, as this can cause the blade to dig into the surface.
4. For stubborn areas, increase pressure gradually.

4.2 Precision Scraping

For detailed work on windows, moldings, or in narrow corners, utilize the pointed edges of the triangular blade. The ergonomic design allows for increased control in these areas.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and effectiveness of your Bahco Ergo Pocket Scraper.

5.1 Blade Replacement

The carbide blade is replaceable. When one edge becomes dull, the blade can be rotated to expose a fresh edge. Once all three edges are dull, replace the blade.

1. Locate the screw securing the blade to the scraper head.
2. Using an appropriate screwdriver, carefully loosen and remove the screw.
3. Remove the old blade.
4. Insert a new or rotated blade, ensuring it is correctly seated.
5. Re-insert and tighten the screw securely. Do not overtighten.

5.2 Cleaning and Storage

After each use, clean any debris or residue from the blade and scraper body. Store the scraper in its provided carrying sheath to protect the blade and prevent accidental injury. Store in a dry place away from moisture.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your scraper, consider the following:

- **Ineffective Scraping:** The blade may be dull. Rotate the blade to a fresh edge or replace it.
- **Gouging Surface:** Ensure you are holding the scraper at a shallow angle and applying even pressure. Avoid excessive force.
- **Blade Looseness:** Check that the blade screw is tightened securely.
