1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, installation, and maintenance of your Phoenix Gold ARX.805 Stereo Interconnect RCA Cables. These cables are designed to provide high-quality audio signal transfer between compatible audio components.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- Stereo Interconnect RCA Cable: Designed for stereo audio signal transmission.
- True Balanced-Directional Design: Engineered for optimal signal flow and noise rejection.

3. SETUP AND CONNECTION

The Phoenix Gold ARX.805 cables are designed for straightforward connection between audio components. Follow these steps for proper setup:

- Identify Ports: Locate the RCA audio output ports on your source device (e.g., CD Player, Turntable, Audio Receiver) and the RCA audio input ports on your receiving device (e.g., Amplifier, Stereo System, Home Theater System). RCA ports are typically color-coded: red for the right channel and white (or black) for the left channel.
- 2. Power Off Devices: Ensure both the source and receiving audio devices are powered off before

making any connections. This prevents potential damage to the equipment or the cables.

- 3. **Connect Source:** Insert the RCA connectors from one end of the Phoenix Gold ARX.805 cable into the corresponding output ports of your source device. Match the red connector to the red port (right channel) and the white/black connector to the white/black port (left channel).
- 4. **Connect Receiving Device:** Insert the RCA connectors from the other end of the cable into the corresponding input ports of your receiving device. Again, ensure the red connector goes into the red port and the white/black connector into the white/black port.
- 5. **Secure Connections:** Gently push the connectors firmly into place to ensure a secure and stable connection. Avoid excessive force.
- 6. Power On Devices: Once all connections are secure, you may power on your audio components.

Compatible Devices: These cables are compatible with a wide range of audio equipment, including but not limited to: CD Players, Stereo Systems, Keyboard Amplifiers, Drum Machines, DJ Equipment, Audio Receivers, Equalizers, Headphone Amplifiers, Amplifiers, Home Theater Systems, Turntables, Tape Decks, Microphone Amplifiers, and Guitar Amplifiers.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the Phoenix Gold ARX.805 cables are correctly connected between your audio components, their operation is passive. The cables facilitate the transfer of audio signals. Ensure your audio source is playing and your receiving device is set to the correct input for the connected source. Adjust volume levels on your amplifier or receiver as needed.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Phoenix Gold ARX.805 cables, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Handle with Care: Avoid sharp bends, kinks, or excessive pulling on the cables, especially near the connectors.
- **Keep Clean:** Periodically wipe the cables and connectors with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to remove dust and grime. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Store Properly: When not in use, coil the cables loosely and store them in a cool, dry place away
 from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspect Connectors:** Occasionally check the gold-plated connectors for any signs of corrosion or damage. Ensure they remain clean and free of debris.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with audio signal transfer, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

• No Audio or Intermittent Sound:

- Ensure all RCA connectors are fully seated and secure in their respective ports on both the source and receiving devices.
- Verify that the correct input source is selected on your amplifier or receiver.
- Check the volume levels on all connected audio components.
- Test the cables with another set of audio components if available, to rule out issues with the cables themselves.

• Humming or Buzzing Noise:

- Ensure all components are properly grounded.
- Check for any loose connections.
- Move the audio cables away from power cables or other sources of electromagnetic interference.

• Distorted Audio:

- Verify that the input levels on your receiving device are not overdriven.
- Ensure the cables are not damaged (e.g., visible kinks or cuts).
