Campingaz Super Carena® Single Burner Stove User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

The Campingaz Super Carena Single Burner Stove is a robust and powerful cooking appliance designed for outdoor use. It features an integrated windscreen to optimize heat transfer and maintain flame stability. This stove is compatible with refillable Campingaz cylinders R904 and R907.

Key features include:

- Power output: 3,000 W
- Boil time: Approximately 4 minutes for 1 liter of water
- Runtime: Up to 8 hours on R904 cylinder, 12 hours on R907 cylinder
- Integrated windscreen for improved efficiency
- Adjustable power control

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions could result in fire, explosion, serious injury, or death.

- **FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY:** Never operate this appliance indoors, in a garage, or any enclosed area. Carbon monoxide poisoning can occur.
- **VENTILATION:** Ensure adequate ventilation when operating.
- **FLAMMABLE MATERIALS:** Keep the stove clear of all flammable materials, including tents, clothing, and dry vegetation. Maintain a minimum distance of 1 meter (3 feet) from combustible surfaces.
- **STABILITY:** Always place the stove on a firm, level, non-combustible surface. Ensure the gas cylinder is stable and upright.

- **GAS CYLINDER CONNECTION:** Connect and disconnect gas cylinders in a well-ventilated area, preferably outdoors, and away from any ignition sources (e.g., open flames, pilot lights, electric motors).
- **LEAK CHECK:** Always check for gas leaks after connecting a new cylinder or if you suspect a leak. Use soapy water; never use an open flame. Bubbles indicate a leak.
- **CHILDREN AND PETS:** Keep children and pets away from the stove during operation and while it is cooling down.
- **NEVER LEAVE UNATTENDED:** Do not leave the operating stove unattended.
- **HOT SURFACES:** The stove and cooking utensils will become extremely hot during use. Allow ample time for cooling before handling or storing.
- **TRANSPORT:** Ensure the gas cylinder is disconnected and the stove is cool before transporting.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Campingaz Super Carena Single Burner Stove package should contain the following:

- 1 x Campingaz Super Carena Single Burner Stove (Chrome finish)

Please note: Gas cylinders (R904 or R907) are sold separately and are not included with the stove.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack the Stove:** Carefully remove all packaging materials from the stove.
2. **Choose a Location:** Select a flat, stable, non-combustible surface outdoors, away from any flammable materials, buildings, or tents. Ensure good ventilation.
3. **Prepare the Gas Cylinder:** Ensure your Campingaz R904 or R907 cylinder is upright and stable.
4. **Connect the Stove to the Cylinder:**
 - Ensure the stove's control knob is in the 'OFF' position.
 - Align the stove's connector with the valve on the gas cylinder.
 - Screw the stove onto the cylinder by hand until it is finger-tight. Do not overtighten.
 - Perform a leak check (see Safety Information section).

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ignition:

- Ensure the stove is securely connected to the gas cylinder.
- Slowly turn the control knob counter-clockwise to allow a small amount of gas to flow. You should hear a faint hiss.
- Immediately apply a flame from a match or lighter to the burner head. The burner should ignite.
- If the burner does not ignite within a few seconds, turn the control knob to 'OFF', wait a minute for gas to dissipate, and repeat the process.

2. Flame Adjustment:

- Once ignited, adjust the flame intensity by rotating the control knob. Turn clockwise to decrease the flame and counter-clockwise to increase it.
- The integrated windscreen helps maintain flame stability even in breezy conditions.

3. Cooking:

- Place your cooking pot or pan securely on the stove's pot supports.
- Monitor your cooking and adjust the flame as needed.

4. Shutting Down:

- When finished cooking, turn the control knob fully clockwise to the 'OFF' position until the flame extinguishes.
- Allow the stove to cool completely before handling or disconnecting the gas cylinder.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your stove.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, once the stove has cooled, wipe down the burner and pot supports with a damp cloth to remove any food spills or grease. For stubborn stains, a mild detergent can be used. Ensure the stove is completely dry before storage.
- **Burner Head:** Periodically check the burner head for any blockages (e.g., food debris, insects). Use a soft brush or compressed air to clear any obstructions.
- **Storage:** Store the stove in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure the gas cylinder is disconnected before storage.
- **Inspection:** Before each use, inspect the stove for any signs of damage, wear, or corrosion. Pay particular attention to the gas connection point and the control knob. Do not use if damaged.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your stove, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stove does not ignite.	No gas flow; empty cylinder; clogged burner.	Ensure cylinder is connected correctly and has gas. Check for blockages in the burner head.
Flame is weak or inconsistent.	Low gas level; partial blockage; cold cylinder.	Replace cylinder if low. Clean burner. If cold, warm cylinder slightly (do not heat directly).
Gas smell detected.	Gas leak.	Immediately turn off gas. Perform a leak check with soapy water. Tighten connections or replace faulty parts. Do not use if leak persists.
Stove makes a loud roaring noise.	Too much gas flow.	Adjust the control knob to reduce gas flow.
