## INTRODUCTION

---

The SoyQuick Automatic Soymilk Maker SDZ-5 is designed to simplify the process of making fresh plant-based milks at home. This appliance allows you to create soymilk, rice milk, almond milk, oat milk, and other raw milks efficiently. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your new SoyQuick SDZ-5 to ensure safe and optimal performance.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

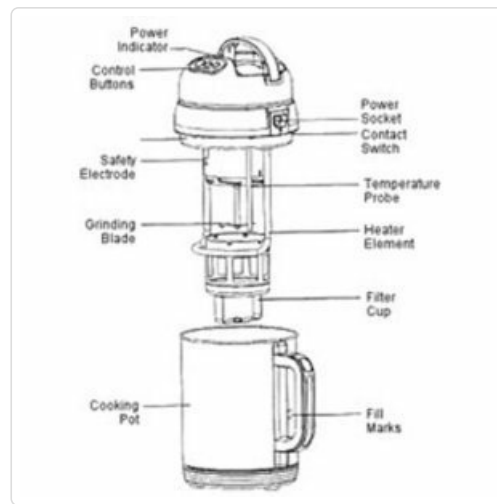

- Always ensure the appliance is unplugged before cleaning or when not in use.
- Do not immerse the motor unit or electrical components in water or other liquids.
- Keep hands and utensils away from moving parts during operation to prevent injury.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Contact customer support for assistance.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors.
- Ensure the lid is securely in place before starting the machine.
- Allow the machine to cool down before cleaning or storing.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

Familiarize yourself with the components of your SoyQuick SDZ-5.

## Main Components:

- **Motor Head Unit:** Contains the motor, grinding blade, and heating element.
- **Pitcher/Container:** The main vessel for water and ingredients.
- **Control Panel:** Buttons for operation and indicator lights.
- **Power Cord:** For connecting to an electrical outlet.
- **Strainer:** Used to filter the finished milk (often included as an accessory).

## SETUP

---

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the pitcher, strainer, and the underside of the motor head unit (avoiding electrical parts) with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the exterior of the motor head unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the SoyQuick SDZ-5 on a stable, flat, and dry surface, away from heat sources and direct sunlight. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.
4. **Assembly:** Place the pitcher on the base. Carefully align the motor head unit with the pitcher and lower it until it is securely seated. Ensure it clicks into place if applicable.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### General Operation for Soymilk:

1. **Prepare Soybeans:** Soak 1/2 to 1 cup of dry soybeans in water for 6-8 hours, or overnight. Drain and rinse the soaked beans.
2. **Add Ingredients:** Pour the recommended amount of water (refer to the pitcher's fill lines, typically between 1.1 to 1.3 liters) into the pitcher. Add the soaked and rinsed soybeans. Do not exceed the maximum fill line.
3. **Secure Lid:** Place the motor head unit onto the pitcher, ensuring it is properly sealed.
4. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a grounded electrical outlet. The indicator light may illuminate.
5. **Select Program:** Press the "Soymilk" or "Start" button on the control panel. The machine will begin

its cycle, which typically involves heating, grinding, and cooking. The cycle duration is approximately 13-15 minutes.

6. **Completion:** The machine will beep or an indicator light will change when the cycle is complete. Unplug the unit.
7. **Strain Milk:** Carefully remove the motor head unit. Pour the hot soymilk through the provided strainer into another container to separate the okara (pulp).
8. **Serve:** Your fresh soymilk is ready. It can be served warm or chilled. Store any unused soymilk in the refrigerator.

## Making Other Plant-Based Milks:

The SoyQuick SDZ-5 can also make other milks. Adjust ingredient quantities and soaking times as follows:

- **Rice Milk:** Use 1/2 cup of cooked rice (or 1/4 cup uncooked, soaked rice). Follow general operating steps.
- **Almond Milk:** Soak 1/2 cup of almonds overnight. Drain and rinse. Follow general operating steps.
- **Oat Milk:** Use 1/2 cup of rolled oats. Soaking is optional but can improve texture. Follow general operating steps.
- **Raw Milks:** For raw milks (e.g., raw almond milk), use the "Raw" or "No Heat" setting if available, or simply blend soaked ingredients with cold water and strain.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your SoyQuick SDZ-5.

1. **Immediate Cleaning:** After each use, unplug the machine and allow it to cool slightly.
2. **Clean Pitcher and Strainer:** Wash the pitcher and strainer with warm, soapy water using a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse thoroughly.
3. **Clean Motor Head Unit:** Carefully clean the underside of the motor head unit, especially around the blade and heating element, with a brush or sponge. **Do not immerse the motor head unit in water.** Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth.
4. **Drying:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing.
5. **Storage:** Store the SoyQuick SDZ-5 in a clean, dry place.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start.	Not plugged in; lid not properly secured; power outage.	Check power connection; ensure lid is correctly seated; check household power.
Milk is too thin/watery.	Insufficient ingredients; too much water.	Increase amount of beans/grains; reduce water to recommended level.
Milk is too thick/gritty.	Too many ingredients; not enough water; insufficient straining.	Reduce amount of beans/grains; add more water (within limits); strain thoroughly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unusual noise during operation.	Foreign object in grinding chamber; machine not stable.	Unplug and inspect grinding chamber for obstructions; ensure machine is on a flat surface.
Overflow during cooking.	Overfilled with water or ingredients.	Do not exceed the maximum fill line for water and ingredients.
