BANDAI SPIRITS Gundam MS-06R-1 Zaku II Shin Matsunaga Custom MG 1/100 Scale Model Kit Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your BANDAI SPIRITS Gundam MS-06R-1 Zaku II Shin Matsunaga Custom MG 1/100 Scale model kit. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly to ensure a smooth and enjoyable building experience. This kit is designed for enthusiasts and requires careful attention to detail during construction.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Small Parts Warning:** This kit contains small parts and is not suitable for children under 3 years old due to choking hazards.
- **Sharp Edges:** Exercise caution when cutting parts from the runners, as some edges may be sharp. Use appropriate tools such as hobby nippers.
- **Adhesives/Paints:** If using optional adhesives or paints, ensure proper ventilation and follow the manufacturer's safety guidelines for those products.
- **Disposal:** Dispose of plastic waste and packaging materials responsibly.

PARTS LIST

Before starting assembly, verify that all components are present. Refer to the detailed parts list and runner diagrams provided in the physical instruction booklet included with your kit. Each runner is typically labeled with a letter (e.g., A, B, C) and individual parts are numbered (e.g., A1, B5).

ASSEMBLY (SETUP)

The Gundam MS-06R-1 Zaku II Shin Matsunaga Custom kit features a snap-fit assembly design, meaning no glue is required for basic construction. Follow the step-by-step diagrams in the included instruction booklet.

1. **Preparation:** Lay out all runners and identify the parts needed for each step. Use a hobby nipper to carefully cut parts from the runners. Avoid pulling or twisting parts, as this can cause stress marks or breakage.
2. **Part Removal:** Cut the part from the runner with a small amount of plastic still attached (a 'gate'). Then, use a second cut closer to the part to remove the remaining gate, ensuring a clean finish.
3. **Assembly Sequence:** Follow the numerical order of the steps in the instruction booklet. Pay close attention to the orientation of parts and any specific connection points.
4. **Snap-Fit Connections:** Gently press parts together until they 'snap' into place. Do not force parts, as this can damage the pegs or holes. If a connection is too tight, carefully trim a small amount of plastic from the peg.
5. **Articulation:** During assembly of joints, ensure they move freely but are not loose. Some joints may require a small amount of force to articulate for the first time.

OPERATING (DISPLAY AND POSING)

Once assembled, your Gundam model is ready for display and posing. The Master Grade (MG) series is known for its high level of articulation, allowing for a wide range of dynamic poses.

- **Joint Movement:** Gently manipulate the joints to achieve desired poses. Avoid excessive force,

especially on smaller or thinner parts.

- **Stability:** Ensure the model is balanced when posing to prevent it from falling. Consider using an action base (sold separately) for more dynamic or aerial poses.
- **Accessory Handling:** Attach and detach weapons and accessories carefully. Some accessories may have specific connection points.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will help preserve the appearance and integrity of your model kit.

- **Cleaning:** Dust your model regularly using a soft brush or a can of compressed air. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, which can damage the plastic or paint.
- **Storage:** Store the model in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent discoloration or degradation of plastic over time.
- **Loose Joints:** If joints become loose over time, a small amount of clear nail polish or hobby-specific joint tightener can be applied to the peg and allowed to dry before reassembly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Missing or Damaged Parts:** If you discover any missing or damaged parts upon opening the kit, please contact the retailer or BANDAI SPIRITS customer support with proof of purchase.
- **Parts Not Fitting:** Double-check the instruction manual to ensure you are using the correct parts and orientation. If a part is slightly too large, carefully trim it with a hobby knife. Do not force parts.
- **Stress Marks:** White stress marks on plastic usually occur from excessive force during cutting or assembly. These can sometimes be minimized with careful sanding or by applying a small amount of plastic cement (use with caution).
