3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Andis UltraEdge Clipper Blades are designed for easy attachment and detachment. These blades are compatible with a wide range of Andis detachable blade animal clippers, including models such as AG, AGP, AGR+, AGC, AGCL, AGRC, AGRV, SMC, and MBG Clippers.

Blade Attachment:

1. Ensure your clipper is turned off and unplugged from the power source before attaching or detaching any blade.

2. Align the blade with the clipper's blade hinge.
3. Push the blade down until it snaps securely into place. A click indicates proper installation.

Blade Detachment:

1. Turn off and unplug the clipper.
2. Locate the blade release button or lever on your clipper (refer to your clipper's manual for exact location).
3. Press the release mechanism and gently lift the blade off the hinge.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Andis UltraEdge Clipper Blades are designed for efficient and smooth grooming across various hair types. For optimal performance and to ensure a comfortable experience for the animal, follow these guidelines:

- **Preparation:** Ensure the animal's coat is clean, dry, and free of tangles before grooming. A clean coat helps the blade glide smoothly and prevents premature dulling.
- **Blade Lubrication:** Always apply a few drops of clipper oil to the blade teeth before each use and periodically during extended grooming sessions. This reduces friction, heat, and wear.
- **Grooming Technique:** Hold the clipper firmly and move it smoothly against the direction of hair growth. Use even, consistent strokes to achieve a uniform cut.
- **Heat Management:** Blades can heat up during prolonged use. If the blade becomes too hot to touch, turn off the clipper, remove the blade, and allow it to cool. Using a blade coolant spray can also help manage heat.
- **Specialty Cat Blades:** When grooming felines, utilize the EGT UltraEdge Cat Blades (available in spring green) which feature a specialized tooth pattern to minimize track lines in delicate cat coats.

5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance is crucial for extending the life and performance of your Andis UltraEdge Clipper Blades.

- **Cleaning After Each Use:** After each grooming session, brush away any loose hair from the blade teeth using a small brush.
- **Lubrication:** Regularly apply Andis clipper oil to the blade. This lubricates the moving parts, reduces friction, and helps prevent rust.
- **Rust Prevention:** The chrome finish and EGT coating on certain blades provide resistance to rust and corrosion. However, it is important to keep blades dry and oiled.
- **Storage:** Store blades in a dry, clean environment. Blade cases or organizers are recommended to protect the cutting edges from damage.
- **Sharpening:** Over time, even the highest quality blades will dull. When your blade no longer cuts efficiently, it may need professional sharpening. Do not attempt to sharpen blades yourself unless you have specialized tools and training.
- **Important Note:** *Do not wash blades with water.* While the blades are designed to resist corrosion, direct washing with water can compromise their performance and longevity. Use blade cleaning solutions or sprays specifically designed for clipper blades.

6. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please observe the following safety precautions when using your Andis UltraEdge Clipper Blade:

- Avoid direct eye contact with blades during operation.
- Exercise caution to prevent cutting the skin of the animal being groomed.
- Always ensure the clipper device is unplugged from the power source when not in use, or when attaching/detaching blades, or performing maintenance.
- Keep blades out of reach of children and pets.

- **Blade Getting Hot:**

- Apply blade coolant spray.
- Ensure the blade is properly oiled.
- Allow the blade to cool down by resting the clipper or using a second blade.

- **Blade Pulling Hair:**

- Ensure the animal's coat is clean, dry, and detangled.
- Check for dullness or damage to the blade teeth.
- Verify the blade is correctly attached to the clipper.
