1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe installation, operation, and maintenance of your BabyDan No-Trip Metal Safety Gate, Model 5224-200-01-75. This gate is designed to provide a secure barrier for children, preventing access to hazardous areas such as stairs or specific rooms. Its key features include a wall-mounted design, a no-trip bar for enhanced safety, and a mechanism that allows opening in both directions.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Read all instructions carefully before installation and use.** Keep this manual for future reference.
- This safety gate is intended for domestic use only.
- This safety gate is suitable for use with children up to 24 months of age.
- **WARNING:** Incorrect installation can be dangerous. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- **WARNING:** Never use without wall cups.
- The safety barrier must not be fitted across windows.
- Regularly check that the safety barrier is correctly installed and secure.
- Do not leave children unattended near the safety gate.
- Stop using the gate if any components are damaged or missing.
- Ensure the gate is always closed and latched when not in use.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please ensure all components are present before beginning installation. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with installation and contact customer support.

- Wall mounting kit (includes wall cups, screws, and wall plugs)

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The BabyDan No-Trip Metal Safety Gate is designed for wall-mounted installation and fits openings between 72.5 cm and 79 cm. Tools required: drill, screwdriver, pencil, measuring tape.

1. **Measure the Opening:** Carefully measure the width of the opening where the gate will be installed. Ensure it is within the specified range of 72.5 cm to 79 cm.
2. **Position the Gate:** Hold the gate in the desired position. The bottom bar of the gate should be flush with the floor or step.
3. **Mark Wall Cup Positions:** Place the wall cups against the wall at the top and bottom corners of the gate frame. Use a pencil to mark the screw holes for each wall cup.
4. **Drill Pilot Holes:** Using an appropriate drill bit for your wall type, drill pilot holes at the marked positions. Insert wall plugs if necessary.
5. **Attach Wall Cups:** Securely fasten the wall cups to the wall using the provided screws. Ensure they are firmly attached.
6. **Mount the Gate:** Align the gate's mounting points with the installed wall cups. Carefully push the gate into place until it clicks securely into the wall cups.
7. **Test Security:** Gently push and pull the gate to ensure it is firmly mounted and does not wobble. Check that the latch mechanism engages correctly.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To open the BabyDan No-Trip Metal Safety Gate:

1. Locate the latch mechanism, typically at the top of the gate.
2. Press the release button or slide the latch according to its design.
3. While holding the release, gently lift the gate handle and swing the gate open. The gate is designed to open in both directions.

To close the gate:

- Swing the gate back into the closed position.
- Ensure the latch mechanism automatically engages and locks the gate securely. You should hear a click.
- Always double-check that the gate is properly latched before leaving a child unattended.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the gate regularly with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish or materials.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect the gate for any signs of wear, damage, or loose components. Check all screws, wall cups, and the latch mechanism to ensure they are secure and functioning correctly.
- **Lubrication:** If the gate hinges become stiff, a small amount of silicone-based lubricant can be applied to the moving parts.
- **Storage:** If storing the gate for an extended period, ensure it is clean and dry. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Gate feels loose or wobbly:**
 - Check that all wall cups are securely fastened to the wall. Tighten screws if necessary.
 - Ensure the gate frame is properly seated in the wall cups.
- **Gate does not latch properly:**
 - Inspect the latch mechanism for any obstructions or damage.
 - Verify that the gate is installed squarely within the opening. Slight adjustments to the wall cup positions may be needed.
- **Gate is difficult to open/close:**
 - Check for any debris or foreign objects obstructing the hinges or latch.
 - Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to the hinges if they are stiff.
