INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Altec Lansing VS2221 2.1 Music & Gaming Speaker System. This system is designed to provide high-quality audio for your music and gaming experiences, featuring a powerful subwoofer and two satellite speakers for a rich, immersive sound. Its distinctive styling complements any setup, and the SFX Technology enhances the stereo image for a broader soundstage.

This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your speaker system. Please read it carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your product.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unpacking your Altec Lansing VS2221 speaker system, please ensure all the following components are present:

- 1 x Subwoofer
- 2 x Satellite Speakers
- Power Cable (integrated or separate, depending on model revision)
- Audio Input Cable (3.5mm stereo jack)

SETUP

- 1. **Placement:** Position the subwoofer on the floor, preferably near a wall or in a corner for enhanced bass response. Place the satellite speakers on either side of your monitor or listening area, ensuring they are equidistant from your listening position for optimal stereo imaging. The satellites are shielded for use near video monitors.
- 2. **Connect Satellite Speakers:** Connect the cables from the satellite speakers to the corresponding output jacks on the back of the subwoofer. Ensure a secure connection.
- 3. **Connect Audio Source:** Connect the 3.5mm audio input cable from the subwoofer to the audio output jack (headphone jack or line-out) of your computer, gaming console, MP3 player, or other audio device.

4. Connect Power: Plug the power cable from the subwoofer into a standard AC power outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Power On/Off: Locate the power button/switch, typically on one of the satellite speakers or the subwoofer. Press it to turn the system on or off. An indicator light will usually illuminate when the system is powered on.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the master volume using the dedicated volume knob. Turn clockwise to increase volume and counter-clockwise to decrease.
- **Subwoofer Level:** The subwoofer may have a separate control knob to adjust its bass level independently. Adjust this to your preference for optimal bass response.
- **SFX Technology:** The VS2221 features SFX Technology for a wider stereo image. Locate the SFX switch and toggle it to experience the enhanced soundstage for music and games.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker surfaces. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as they may damage the finish.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the subwoofer and satellite speakers have adequate ventilation. Do not block any vents or place the speakers in enclosed spaces that could lead to overheating.
- Cable Management: Keep cables tidy and untangled to prevent damage and ensure proper connectivity. Avoid sharp bends or kinks in the cables.
- **Storage:** If storing the speakers for an extended period, disconnect them from power and audio sources, and store them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speakers.	Speakers not powered on. Volume turned down. Audio cable disconnected or faulty. Incorrect audio source selected on device.	Ensure power is on and indicator light is lit. Increase master volume. Check all audio connections. Try a different cable. Verify audio output settings on your device.
Distorted or unclear sound.	Volume too high. Subwoofer level too high. Poor audio source quality. Interference from other devices.	Reduce master volume. Adjust subwoofer level. Try a different audio source. Move speakers away from mobile phones, Wi-Fi routers, or other electronic devices.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Static or crackling noise (especially when adjusting volume).	Dust or wear in volume potentiometer. Electrical interference.	Rotate the volume knob fully back and forth several times to clear dust. If persistent, professional service may be required. Ensure power cables are not running parallel to audio cables. Try plugging into a different power outlet.




