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1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Poolmaster Manual Pool Vacuum Hose. This hose is designed to provide efficient and reliable manual cleaning for both inground and above-ground swimming pools. Its heavy-duty construction and kink-free design ensure a smooth and effective cleaning experience. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your new pool vacuum hose.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION & COMPATIBILITY

- **Manual Use Only:** This hose is designed exclusively for use with a manual pool vacuum head and a standard telescopic pool pole. It is **NOT compatible** with automatic or robotic pool cleaners. Attempting to use it with incompatible equipment may result in damage to the hose or cleaner.
- **Proposition 65 Warning:** This product may contain chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. Wash hands after handling.
- **Inspect Before Use:** Always inspect the hose for any signs of damage, cracks, or wear before each use. Do not use a damaged hose.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to properly set up your Poolmaster Manual Pool Vacuum Hose:

1. **Attach to Vacuum Head:** Connect the swivel cuff end of the hose directly to your manual pool vacuum head. Ensure a secure fit to prevent air leaks.
2. **Attach to Telescopic Pole:** Secure your manual vacuum head to a standard telescopic pool pole (sold separately).
3. **Submerge Hose:** Slowly submerge the vacuum head and hose into the pool water, allowing the hose to fill completely with water. This removes air from the hose, which is crucial for effective suction.
4. **Connect to Skimmer/Vacuum Inlet:** Once the hose is full of water and all air bubbles have escaped, connect the non-swivel end of the hose to your pool's skimmer or dedicated vacuum inlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the hose is properly set up and connected, you can begin vacuuming your pool:

1. **Start Vacuuming:** With the pool pump running, slowly move the vacuum head across the bottom of your pool. Use slow, deliberate strokes to avoid stirring up debris.
2. **Monitor Suction:** Ensure consistent suction. If suction decreases, check for air leaks in connections or blockages in the hose or skimmer basket.
3. **Kink-Free Operation:** The swivel cuff helps prevent the hose from kinking, allowing for smoother maneuverability. If a kink occurs, gently straighten the hose.
4. **Optimal Water Flow:** The spiral-wound construction is designed for optimal water flow, ensuring efficient debris removal.

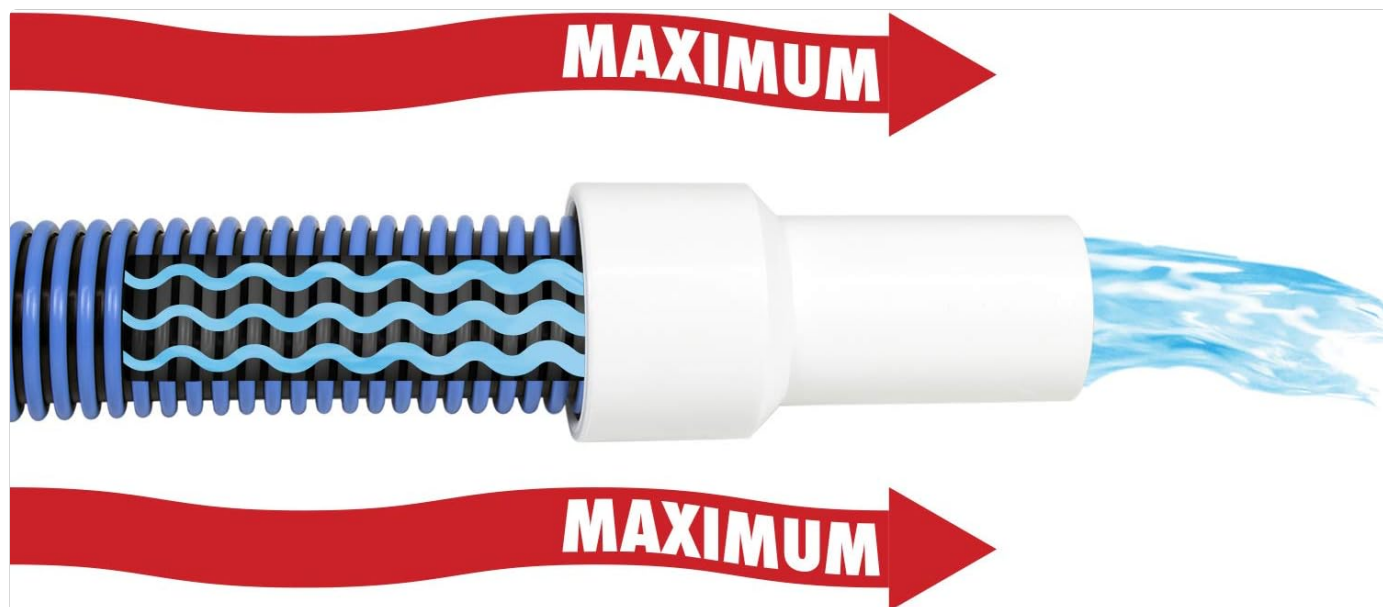


Figure 4.1: The hose's design promotes maximum water flow for effective debris collection.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Poolmaster Manual Pool Vacuum Hose:

- **Rinse After Use:** After each use, rinse the hose thoroughly with fresh water to remove any pool chemicals or debris.
- **Store Properly:** Coil the hose neatly and store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and harsh chemicals. Avoid leaving it exposed to the elements for extended periods.
- **Avoid Sharp Objects:** Do not drag the hose over sharp edges or objects that could puncture or cut the material.
- **Check for Damage:** Periodically inspect the hose for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage to the cuffs. The EVA material is UV- and chemical-resistant, but regular inspection is recommended.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor or no suction	Air in the hose or pump; clogged skimmer basket; loose connections.	Ensure hose is fully submerged and purged of air before connecting. Check and empty skimmer basket. Tighten all connections.
Hose kinks during use	Rapid movement; improper coiling during storage.	Move the vacuum head slowly and steadily. Ensure the hose is coiled loosely and not tightly wound for storage. The swivel cuff is designed to minimize kinking.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hose appears damaged	Physical impact; prolonged exposure to harsh conditions.	Inspect for cuts or cracks. If significant damage is present, replace the hose to maintain pool cleaning efficiency and safety.
