John Deere Monopoly Collector's Edition Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the John Deere Monopoly Collector's Edition. This game allows players to buy, sell, and trade iconic John Deere equipment, celebrating the legacy of one of the most revered agricultural and forestry equipment manufacturers. Experience the entrepreneurial spirit of John Deere while engaging in the world's most popular board game.

Key Features:

- Customized game board featuring the most sought-after John Deere equipment throughout the company's history.
- Familiar, traditional Monopoly game play mechanics.
- Collectible pewter tokens including a Model "D" tractor, Model "B" tractor, 9620 tractor, L110 Lawn & Garden tractor, 650H Dozer, and the original John Deere plow.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all game components from the box. Verify that all pieces are present: game board, 6 collectible pewter tokens, 2 dice, 32 Machine Sheds (houses), 12 Garages (hotels), 16 Tune Up cards, 16 Combine cards, 1 pack of Monopoly money, and 28 Title Deed cards.
2. **Place Game Board:** Unfold the game board and place it on a flat surface.

3. **Separate Cards:** Separate the Tune Up cards and Combine cards. Shuffle each deck individually and place them face down on their designated spaces on the game board.
4. **Banker Selection:** Each player rolls one die. The player with the highest roll becomes the Banker. The Banker is responsible for managing the bank's money, Title Deeds, Machine Sheds, and Garages. The Banker may also play, but must keep their personal money separate from the bank's

funds.

5. **Initial Funds:** The Banker distributes \$1500 to each player in the following denominations:

- Two \$500 bills
- Two \$100 bills
- Two \$50 bills
- Six \$20 bills
- Five \$10 bills
- Five \$5 bills
- Five \$1 bills

6. **Token Placement:** Each player chooses one of the 6 collectible pewter tokens and places it on the "GO" space.




Image: Close-up view of the collectible pewter tokens, including various John Deere tractor models and a plow.

OPERATING (GAMEPLAY)

The objective of John Deere Monopoly is to be the last player remaining with money, owning all properties and driving other players into bankruptcy.

1. **Starting the Game:** The player to the left of the Banker starts the game. Play proceeds clockwise.
2. **Player Turn:** On your turn, roll both dice and move your token clockwise around the board the number of spaces indicated by the dice.
3. **Landing on Spaces:**

- **Unowned Property:** If you land on an unowned John Deere equipment property (e.g., 9020 Series, Combine), you may buy it from the Bank for the price printed on that space. If you choose not to buy it, the Banker immediately auctions it to the highest bidder.

- **Owned Property:** If you land on a property owned by another player, you must pay rent to that player according to the Title Deed card. Rent increases if the owner has Machine Sheds or Garages on the property.
 - **Tune Up or Combine:** Draw the top card from the respective deck and follow its instructions.
 - **Go:** When you pass or land on "GO", collect \$200 from the Bank.
 - **Go to Jail:** Move your token directly to the "In Jail" space. You do not collect \$200 for passing "GO".
 - **Free Parking:** This is a safe space; nothing happens.
 - **Income Tax/Luxury Tax:** Pay the amount indicated to the Bank.
4. **Doubles:** If you roll doubles, take your turn as usual, then roll again. If you roll doubles three times in a row, you must immediately "Go to Jail".
 5. **Building:** Once you own all properties in a color group, you can buy Machine Sheds and Garages from the Bank and place them on your properties to increase rent. You must build evenly across the color group.
 6. **Selling Properties/Mortgaging:** You can sell properties to other players or mortgage them to the Bank for half their value to raise money. Mortgaged properties do not collect rent.
 7. **Bankruptcy:** If you owe more money than you can pay, even by selling all your buildings and mortgaging all your properties, you are bankrupt and out of the game. All your properties and assets are turned over to the player you owe money to, or to the Bank if you owe the Bank.
 8. **Winning the Game:** The last player remaining in the game, after all others have gone bankrupt, is the winner.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity of your John Deere Monopoly game.

- **Storage:** Always store all game components neatly back in the original box after play. Ensure the game board is folded correctly to prevent damage.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe down the game board and plastic components if they become dusty. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Handling:** Handle game cards and money with clean, dry hands to prevent wear and tear. Avoid bending or creasing the cards.
- **Environment:** Store the game in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent warping or fading of components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their resolutions during gameplay.

Issue	Resolution
Missing Game Piece	Thoroughly check the game box and surrounding play area. If a piece is genuinely missing, contact customer support for replacement options (see Support section).
Disagreement on Rules	Refer to this instruction manual for clarification. If a situation is not explicitly covered, players should agree on a house rule before continuing play.
Game Board Warping	Ensure the game is stored flat and in a climate-controlled environment. Avoid exposing the board to excessive moisture or heat.
