SETUP

The Piko 62012 Gazebo Toy is largely pre-assembled, as indicated by "Assembly Required: No" in its specifications. However, minor setup may be required for placement and integration into your model environment.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the gazebo from its packaging. Inspect for any damage during transit.
2. **Placement:** Choose a stable, flat surface for the gazebo within your model layout. Ensure it is positioned securely to prevent accidental tipping.
3. **Integration:** If desired, use model adhesive (not included) to permanently secure the gazebo to your baseboard. Ensure any miniature figures or accessories are placed carefully inside.

OPERATING (USAGE)

The Piko 62012 Gazebo Toy is a static model accessory. Its "operation" involves its role in creating a realistic and engaging miniature scene.

- **Scenic Enhancement:** Place the gazebo in a prominent location within your model railway or diorama to add architectural interest and a focal point.
- **Figurine Placement:** Utilize miniature figures (sold separately) to populate the gazebo, creating dynamic and lifelike scenes, such as a garden party or a quiet gathering.
- **Lighting (Optional):** For advanced modelers, consider adding miniature LED lighting (not included) inside the gazebo to illuminate it, especially for evening scenes.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your Piko Gazebo Toy.

- **Cleaning:** Gently dust the gazebo regularly with a soft, dry brush or a microfibre cloth. For stubborn dirt, lightly dampen the cloth with water (do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners).
- **Storage:** When not in use or during transport, store the gazebo in its original packaging or a protective container to prevent dust accumulation and damage.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Keep the model away from direct sunlight, high humidity, and extreme temperature fluctuations to prevent warping, fading, or material degradation. The product is not water resistant.

TROUBLESHOOTING

While the Piko Gazebo Toy is a durable model, minor issues may arise. Here are some common concerns and their solutions:

- **Dust Accumulation:** If dust builds up in intricate areas, use a soft brush or compressed air (from a safe distance) to remove it.
- **Minor Damage (e.g., detached piece):** For small detached plastic pieces, use a suitable model adhesive to reattach them. Ensure the adhesive is compatible with plastic and applied sparingly.
- **Fading Colors:** This can occur if the model is exposed to prolonged direct sunlight. Store the model away from direct light to preserve its colours.
- **Missing Parts:** If you believe parts are missing upon unboxing, contact the retailer or Piko customer support with your purchase details.
