1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Piko G Scale Model Train Building, Leather Goods & Boots Store (Model 62237). This highly detailed miniature is designed to enhance your G Scale model train layout or diorama. Constructed from robust materials, this model offers realistic detail and is intended for enthusiasts aged 14 years and up. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and integration into your layout.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon opening the manufacturer's packaging, please verify that all components for the Leather Goods & Boots Store model building are present and undamaged. The package should contain:

- All necessary parts for the Piko G Scale Leather Goods & Boots Store building.
- Assembly instructions (this manual).

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Piko G Scale Leather Goods & Boots Store model building requires assembly. Follow these general guidelines for construction:

- Preparation:** Unpack all components carefully. Identify each part by referring to the included diagrams (if any, otherwise assume standard model kit assembly). Ensure you have a clean, well-lit workspace.
- Tools Required:** Depending on the model's complexity, you may need model adhesive, a hobby knife, small files, and tweezers. (*Note: Tools are typically not included and must be purchased separately.*)
- Assembly Steps:**
 - Begin by assembling the base structure, ensuring all connections are secure.
 - Attach wall sections, paying attention to alignment and detail.

- Integrate windows, doors, and other facade elements.
 - Construct and attach the roof assembly.
 - Add any decorative elements or signage as per the design.
4. **Drying Time:** Allow adequate drying time for any adhesives used before handling or moving the assembled model.

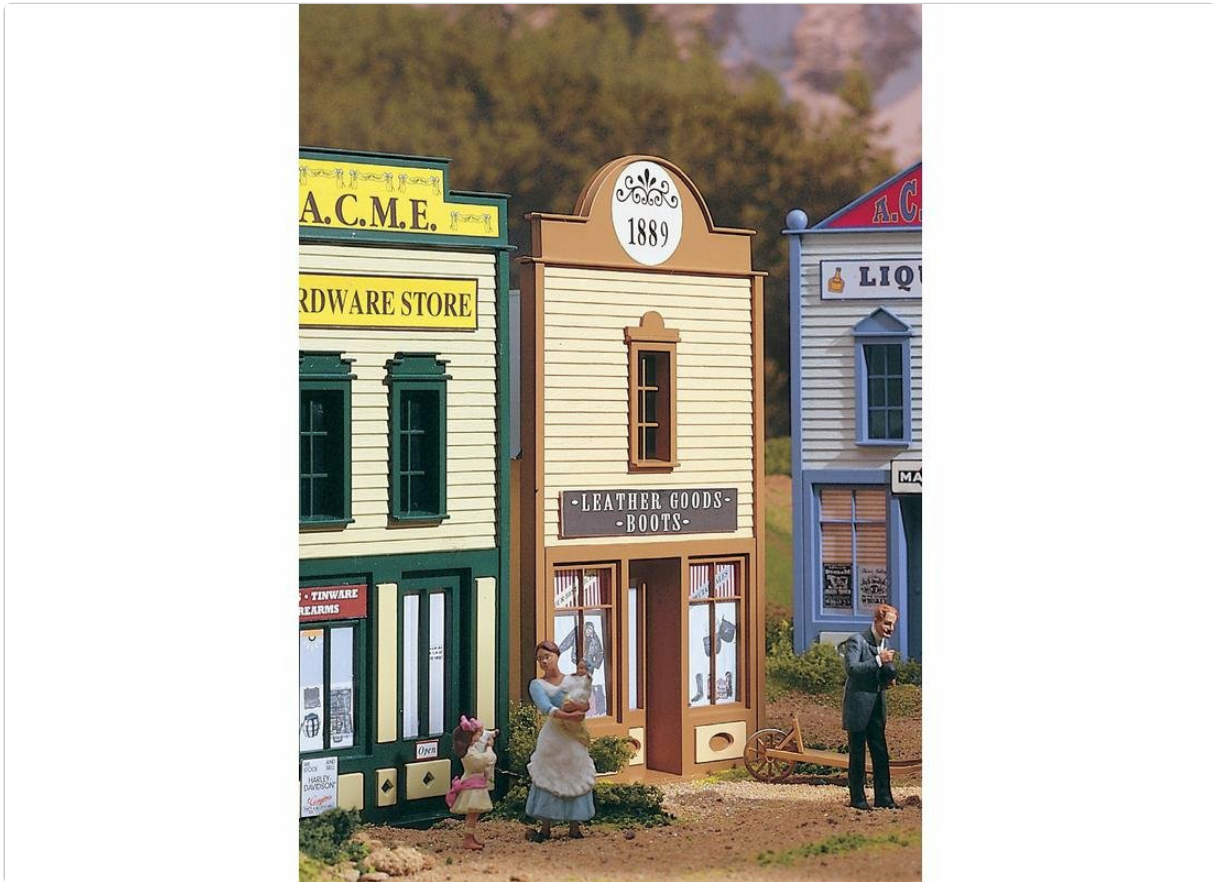

4. OPERATING (PLACEMENT)

Once assembled, the Leather Goods & Boots Store model is ready for integration into your G Scale model train layout or diorama. Consider the following for optimal placement:

- **Location:** Choose a stable, level surface for placement. Ensure the building does not obstruct train movement or other operational elements of your layout.
- **Integration:** Position the store in a way that complements other buildings, scenery, and track elements. It can serve as a focal point in a town or commercial district section of your layout.
- **Securing:** For permanent installations, you may wish to secure the model to the layout base using appropriate adhesives or screws (ensure these do not damage the model or layout).

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your Piko model building, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Dust the model regularly with a soft, dry brush or a can of compressed air. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Handling:** Always handle the model with care, grasping it by its base to avoid damaging delicate

details.

- **Storage:** If storing the model, place it in its original packaging or a protective container to prevent dust accumulation and accidental damage. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

While the Piko G Scale model building is designed for durability, minor issues may arise. Here are some common troubleshooting tips:

- **Loose Parts:** If a small detail or part becomes loose, reattach it carefully using a suitable model adhesive.
- **Dust Accumulation:** For stubborn dust in crevices, use a soft brush or a cotton swab lightly dampened with water (ensure no excess moisture).
- **Damage During Handling:** In case of minor damage, assess if the part can be repaired with adhesive. For significant damage, consider contacting Piko customer support for advice on replacement parts, if available.
