- Monitor burn time and do not allow the flame to touch the container.
- Keep candles out of reach of children and pets.
- Always extinguish candles before engaging in any activities that may involve movement or physical contact.
- Never use candles with broken or cracked containers.
- Always dispose of candle remnants safely and responsibly.
- Always communicate openly and safely with your partner when using candles.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Doc Johnson Japanese Drip Candles are designed for specific recreational use. Each pack contains three candles of assorted colors.

SETUP

- 1. Unpack:** Carefully remove the candles from their packaging.

- 2. Prepare Area:** Choose a non-flammable, stable surface for use. Ensure the area is clear of any combustible materials, drafts, or anything that could be damaged by wax drips.
- 3. Lighting:** Hold the candle upright. Light the wick using a lighter or match. Allow the flame to establish for a few moments before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These candles are designed to produce warm wax drips. Always use with extreme caution and in a controlled environment.

- 1. Positioning:** Hold the lit candle at a safe distance above the desired surface or area. The distance will affect the temperature of the wax upon contact. A greater distance generally results in cooler wax.
- 2. Dripping:** Tilt the candle slightly to allow the melted wax to drip. Control the rate of dripping by adjusting the tilt and distance.
- 3. Monitoring:** Continuously monitor the reaction of the individual receiving the wax. Discontinue use immediately if any discomfort or adverse reaction occurs.
- 4. Extinguishing:** To extinguish the flame, gently blow it out or use a snuffer. Ensure the wick is no longer glowing before setting the candle down.

Note: The wax from these candles is designed to have a lower melting point than standard candles, but it can still cause burns if not used properly. User discretion and careful testing are advised.

MAINTENANCE

- Storage:** Store candles in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and heat sources to prevent melting or warping.
- Wick Trimming:** Before each use, trim the wick to approximately 1/4 inch (6mm). This helps ensure a clean burn and prevents excessive smoking.
- Wax Removal:** Allow any dripped wax to cool and harden completely before attempting to remove it. The wax is designed to flake off, but gentle scraping may be required for stubborn residue. Test on an inconspicuous area first.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wax feels too hot	Candle held too close to skin; individual sensitivity.	Increase the distance between the candle and the skin. Test on a less sensitive area first. Discontinue use if discomfort persists.
Candle smokes excessively	Wick is too long; drafty environment.	Trim the wick to 1/4 inch (6mm). Move to an area free from drafts.
Wax not dripping consistently	Candle not tilted enough; insufficient melted wax pool.	Ensure the candle has burned long enough to create a small pool of melted wax. Adjust the tilt angle.
