Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Timex Easy Reader 35mm Men's Watch, Model T2H291. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece.

Setup

1. Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) out to the furthest position. The second hand will stop.
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hands to the correct time.
3. Push the crown back into its original position to start the watch.

2. Setting the Date

Your watch features a date display at the 3 o'clock position.

1. Pull the crown out to the first click position (halfway out).
2. Turn the crown counter-clockwise (or towards you) until the correct date appears in the date window.
3. Once the date is set, push the crown fully back into its original position.
4. *Note: Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this may interfere with the automatic date change mechanism. If the date changes at noon, advance the time by 12 hours.*

3. Adjusting the Strap

The watch comes with an adjustable 18mm genuine leather strap designed to fit wrist circumferences up to 8 inches. Adjust the buckle to a comfortable fit on your wrist, ensuring it is snug but not too tight.

Operating Instructions

1. Indiglo Night-Light

The Timex Indiglo night-light illuminates the entire watch dial for easy reading in low-light conditions.

- To activate the Indiglo night-light, press and hold the crown.
- The light will remain on as long as the crown is pressed.

2. Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant to 30 meters (100 feet).

- It is suitable for splashes or brief immersion in water.
- It is **not** suitable for swimming, bathing, or diving.
- Do not operate the crown while the watch is wet or submerged.

Maintenance

1. Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by one Lithium Metal battery (CR2016). When the watch stops running or the Indiglo light dims significantly, the battery may need replacement.

- Battery replacement should ideally be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.
- If replacing yourself, carefully open the case back, replace the battery with a new CR2016 cell, and

ensure the gasket is properly seated before closing the case back to maintain water resistance.

2. Cleaning

- Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth.
- For the leather strap, avoid prolonged exposure to water and harsh chemicals. Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary, then dry thoroughly.

3. Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not running	Dead battery; Crown pulled out	Replace battery; Push crown fully in
Indiglo light not working or dim	Low battery	Replace battery
Date not changing at midnight	Time set incorrectly (AM/PM)	Advance time by 12 hours
Condensation under crystal	Water intrusion; Extreme temperature change	Seek professional service immediately to prevent damage
