Sonic Rush is a high-speed 2D action platformer developed by Sonic Team and published by Sega for the Nintendo DS. It features Sonic the Hedgehog and Blaze the Cat as playable characters, each with unique abilities. The game utilizes the dual screens of the Nintendo DS to create expansive levels and dynamic action sequences.

SETUP

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your Nintendo DS system is powered off before inserting or removing the game card.
2. **Insert Game Card:** Locate the game card slot on your Nintendo DS system. Gently push the Sonic Rush game card into the slot until it clicks into place. Ensure the label faces the same direction as the top screen of the DS.
3. **Power On:** Turn on your Nintendo DS system. The game icon for Sonic Rush should appear on the touch screen.
4. **Start Game:** Tap the Sonic Rush icon on the touch screen to begin playing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Controls

- **D-Pad:** Move character (left/right), navigate menus.
- **A Button:** Jump, confirm selections.
- **B Button:** Attack (Spin Dash, Burst Dash), cancel selections.
- **X/Y Buttons:** Special actions (e.g., Boost for Sonic, Fire Boost for Blaze).
- **L/R Buttons:** Camera adjustment (if applicable), special moves.

- **START Button:** Pause game, access menu.
- **SELECT Button:** Not typically used for gameplay in Sonic Rush, may access specific options.
- **Touch Screen:** Used for menu navigation and some in-game interactions.

Gameplay Overview

Sonic Rush features fast-paced side-scrolling action across various zones. The objective is to reach the goal at the end of each act while collecting rings and defeating enemies. The game utilizes both screens of the Nintendo DS, with the action seamlessly transitioning between them. Players can switch between Sonic and Blaze, each offering a distinct play style.

- **Rings:** Collect rings to protect yourself from damage. If you take damage with rings, you will lose them.
- **Chaos Emeralds:** Collect all 7 Chaos Emeralds to unlock the true ending.
- **Boss Battles:** Each zone concludes with a boss battle, requiring strategic attacks to defeat.
- **Special Stages:** Access special stages to earn Chaos Emeralds.

Maintenance

- **Handling:** Always hold the game card by its edges. Avoid touching the metallic connectors.
- **Storage:** Store the game card in its original case or a protective holder when not in use. Keep it away from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, dust, and moisture.
- **Cleaning:** If the metallic connectors on the game card appear dirty, gently wipe them with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquids or abrasive cleaners.
- **System Care:** Ensure your Nintendo DS system is also kept clean and free of dust to prevent issues with game card recognition.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Game does not start or freezes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the game card is fully inserted into the Nintendo DS slot.◦ Remove the game card and reinsert it.◦ Clean the metallic connectors on the game card with a soft, dry cloth.◦ Try the game card in another Nintendo DS system (if available) to determine if the issue is with the game card or the system.
Graphics or sound issues.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Restart the Nintendo DS system.◦ Ensure the game card is clean and properly seated.
Save data corruption.	While rare, save data can become corrupted. Always ensure the system is powered off before removing the game card. If corruption occurs, you may need to start a new game.
