1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2. SETUP GUIDE

2.1. Unpacking and Inspection

- 1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- 2. Verify that all parts listed in the packing slip are present.
- 3. Inspect all components for any signs of shipping damage. Contact customer support immediately if any damage is found.

2.2. Initial Assembly

- 1. Attach the tow bar arms to the central hitch receiver assembly using the provided pins and clips. Ensure all connections are secure.
- 2. Confirm that the arms can extend and retract smoothly.

2.3. Connecting to RV Hitch Receiver

- 1. Slide the tow bar's main shank into your RV's 2-inch hitch receiver.
- 2. Align the hitch pin holes and insert a suitable hitch pin (not included) through both the receiver and the tow bar shank.
- 3. Secure the hitch pin with a cotter pin or locking mechanism to prevent accidental disengagement.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Connecting to Towed Vehicle

- 1. Ensure the towed vehicle is equipped with a compatible Blue Ox base plate.
- 2. Position the towed vehicle directly behind the RV, aligning the base plate tabs with the tow bar arms.
- 3. Extend the tow bar arms and insert the clevis pins into the base plate tabs. Secure each pin with its respective clip.
- 4. Connect the safety cables or chains from the RV to the towed vehicle, ensuring they cross underneath the tow bar to create a cradle in case of separation.
- 5. Connect any necessary electrical wiring for lights and auxiliary braking systems.
- 6. Verify that both tow bar arms are fully extended and locked into place by gently pulling on them.

3.2. Towing Procedures

- 1. Before driving, perform a final check of all connections: tow bar pins, safety chains, and electrical connections.
- 2. Ensure the towed vehicle's transmission is in the correct towing mode (refer to the towed vehicle's owner's manual).
- 3. Drive cautiously, especially during initial movements, turns, and braking. Allow for increased stopping distances.
- 4. Periodically check the tow bar and connections during long trips.

3.3. Disconnecting

- 1. Park the RV and towed vehicle on a level surface.
- 2. Engage the parking brake on both vehicles.
- 3. Disconnect the electrical wiring and safety chains.
- 4. Remove the clips and clevis pins from the base plate tabs, then retract the tow bar arms.
- 5. Remove the hitch pin from the RV's receiver to detach the tow bar.
- 6. Fold the tow bar arms and secure them for storage on the RV.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your Blue Ox Aladdin Tow Bar.

4.1. Cleaning

- After each use, especially in dirty or wet conditions, clean the tow bar thoroughly with mild soap and water.
- Remove any dirt, mud, or road grime from the arms, joints, and locking mechanisms.
- Rinse thoroughly and dry completely to prevent corrosion.

4.2. Lubrication

- · Periodically lubricate all moving parts, including the sliding arms, pivot points, and locking mechanisms.
- Use a high-quality, water-resistant grease or silicone spray as recommended by Blue Ox. Avoid petroleum-based lubricants on rubber components.
- · Apply lubricant sparingly and wipe off any excess.

4.3. Inspection and Storage

- Before each use, inspect the tow bar for any signs of wear, damage, cracks, or loose fasteners. Pay close attention to the arms, joints, and hitch connection.
- Ensure all pins and clips are in good condition and function correctly. Replace any worn or damaged parts immediately.
- When not in use, store the tow bar in a clean, dry place, preferably folded and secured to protect it from the elements.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your tow bar.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty extending/retracting arms	Dirt/debris in sliding mechanism; lack of lubrication; bent arm.	Clean arms thoroughly. Apply lubricant to sliding surfaces. Inspect for damage; if bent, contact Blue Ox support.
Excessive play or noise during towing	Loose connections; worn pins/bushings; improper alignment.	Check all pins and connections for tightness. Inspect pins and bushings for wear and replace if necessary. Ensure proper alignment before towing.
Tow bar not locking into place	Obstruction in locking mechanism; damaged lock.	Clear any debris from the locking mechanism. Inspect the lock for damage. Ensure arms are fully extended.
Safety chains dragging	Chains too long or not crossed.	Shorten chains if possible, or ensure they are crossed underneath the tow bar to create a cradle.
