4. INSTALLATION (SETUP)

The proper functioning of the oil pan is critical for maintaining adequate engine lubrication and preventing engine damage.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Oil Level Checks:** Routinely check your engine oil level using the dipstick and top up as needed with the manufacturer-recommended oil type.

 - **Solution:** A damaged oil pan should be replaced immediately to prevent oil loss and severe engine damage.
