# SPT Sunpentown 1220F Magic Clean Replacement HEPA Filter with Activated Carbon

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The SPT Sunpentown 1220F Magic Clean Replacement HEPA Filter with Activated Carbon is designed specifically for the AC-1220 air purifier. This dual-layer filter system is engineered to significantly improve indoor air quality by capturing a wide range of airborne contaminants.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Power Off:** Before beginning, ensure your SPT AC-1220 air purifier is unplugged from the power outlet.

3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully remove the used HEPA and activated carbon filter assembly. Dispose of the old filter responsibly according to local regulations.
4. **Install New Filter:** Insert the new SPT 1220F replacement filter into the compartment. Ensure it is oriented correctly, with the HEPA filter (white pleated side) facing the direction indicated in your air purifier's manual, and the activated carbon filter (black side) positioned as required. The filter should fit snugly.
5. **Close Compartment:** Securely close the filter access panel.
6. **Restore Power:** Plug the air purifier back into the power outlet.

- **Performance Decline:** Signs that the filter needs replacement include decreased airflow, increased noise from the unit, or a noticeable return of odors or allergens.
- **Cleaning:** The HEPA and activated carbon filter is not washable. Attempting to wash it will damage the filter media and reduce its effectiveness.
