INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the INLAND ProHT Dynamic Stereo Headphones, Model 87050. These headphones are engineered to deliver clear, full-dimension stereo sound from various digital audio sources. This manual provides essential information for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your headphones.

Key Features

SETUP

1. **Unpack the Headphones:** Carefully remove the headphones from their packaging.
2. **Connect to Audio Source:** Insert the 3.5mm miniature jack into the headphone port of your audio device (e.g., computer, smartphone, tablet, stereo system). Ensure the connection is secure.
3. **Adjust Headband:** Place the headphones on your head. Adjust the headband by sliding the ear cups up or down until they rest comfortably over your ears. The headband should fit snugly without causing excessive pressure.
4. **Position Ear Pads:** Ensure the soft cushioned ear pads fully cover your ears for optimal sound and comfort.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Power On/Off:** These headphones do not require external power. They are operational once connected to an audio source.
- **Volume Control:** Use the in-line volume control located on the headphone cable to adjust the audio output level. Slide the control up to increase volume and down to decrease it. You may also adjust the volume directly on your audio source device.
- **Listening:** Begin playing audio from your connected device. Adjust the volume to a comfortable listening level. Prolonged listening at high volumes can cause hearing damage.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:**
 - Wipe the exterior surfaces of the headphones with a soft, dry cloth.
 - For ear pads, use a slightly damp cloth with mild soap if necessary, then wipe dry immediately. Avoid excessive moisture.
 - Do not use harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a clean, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight. Avoid tangling the cable.
- **Cable Care:** Do not pull on the cable to disconnect the headphones. Always grasp the 3.5mm jack directly. Avoid sharp bends or kinks in the cable.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or low volume	3.5mm jack not fully inserted. Volume control on headphones or device is too low. Audio source device is muted or paused. Faulty cable or connection.	Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted into the audio port. Increase volume using the in-line control and on your audio device. Check if the audio source is playing and not muted. Test headphones with another device to rule out a faulty cable.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Distorted sound	Volume set too high. Poor connection. Audio source issue.	Lower the volume on both the headphones and the audio device. Ensure the 3.5mm jack is securely connected. Try a different audio source or audio file.
Uncomfortable fit	Headband not adjusted correctly. Ear pads not positioned properly.	Adjust the headband to find a comfortable position. Ensure ear pads fully cover the ears without excessive pressure.
