Mark Feldstein The Original Singing Bird Clock (Model DLB9821E) Instruction Manual

Your guide to setting up and enjoying your Mark Feldstein Singing Bird Clock.

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Mark Feldstein The Original Singing Bird Clock. This clock is designed to bring the sounds of nature into your home with authentic bird calls on the hour, complemented by a smart light sensor for quiet nights. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper setup and operation.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

The clock requires three (3) AA batteries (not included). Follow these steps for installation:

1. Locate the battery compartments on the back of the clock. There are two compartments: one for the clock movement and one for the bird sounds.
2. Insert one (1) AA battery into the compartment for the clock movement, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
3. Insert two (2) AA batteries into the compartment for the bird sounds, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close both battery compartment covers securely.

2. Setting the Time

Important: To ensure the correct bird song plays at the correct hour, follow these steps precisely:

1. Before installing batteries, manually turn the minute hand counter-clockwise to set the clock hands to 12:50.
2. After setting the hands to 12:50, install the batteries as described above.
3. Use the handset knob on the back of the clock to adjust the time to the desired current time.
4. To synchronize the bird sounds, press the "Test" button (often labeled "Reset" or "Test") on the back of the clock. Each press will advance the bird sound to the next hour. Press until the correct bird sound for the current hour is heard. If you press it too many times, continue pressing until it cycles back to the correct hour.

3. Placement and Display

The clock offers versatile display options:

- **Wall Mount:** Use the integrated hanging slot on the back of the clock to mount it securely on a wall.
- **Tabletop/Desk:** Utilize the built-in stand on the back of the clock for stable placement on any flat surface, such as a desk, shelf, or counter.

OPERATIONS MANUAL

8 inch Original Singing Bird Clock

IMPORTANT! The following instructions must be followed exactly to ensure that the correct sound is heard for each hour.

SETTING THE TIME: (Remove batteries before beginning)

- 1) Turn the hand set knob in rear of movement clockwise or counterclockwise to read 10 minutes before 1:00 o'clock. (12:50)
- 2) Insert 3 "AA" size batteries (not included) into the battery compartments. Make sure that the battery polarity (+/-) is as indicated.
- 3) Turn the handset knob to adjust to desired time.

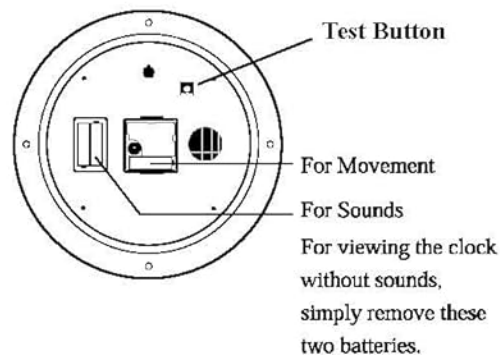
Note: Each time the set test (red) button is pressed, this resets sounds to the next hour. If pressed, you must follow the instructions above to reset properly or you will not hear the correct sounds with each hour.

LIGHT SENSOR (CDS)

This clock has a silence function controlled by a light sensor positioned above the 12 o'clock position. The light sensor automatically turns the sounds off when the room is dark. If the sounds are low, please move to a brighter area of the room.

GENERAL INFORMATION

To clean the outside surface, use a clean, dry, soft cloth to wipe away fingerprints or dust. Do not use any solvents or abrasive cleaners or polish.

BATTERY NOTICE

- 1) Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc), or rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) batteries. To avoid leakage or explosion, do not put batteries in fire.
- 2) Replace the batteries if the timekeeping becomes erratic or hourly sounds become abnormal, as this may be an indication that batteries are becoming worn out.
- 3) Remove the batteries if product is to be left unused for a long time. Clean the battery contacts prior to battery installation.

Hourly Bird Songs

The clock features 12 distinct bird songs that play on the hour, from 6:00 AM to 9:00 PM. Each hour corresponds to a specific bird, as listed below:

1:00 AM: American Robin

2:00 AM: Northern Mockingbird

3:00 AM: Blue Jay

4:00 AM: House Wren

5:00 AM: Tufted Titmouse

6:00 AM: Baltimore Oriole

7:00 AM: Mourning Dove

8:00 AM: Black-capped Chickadee

9:00 AM: Northern Cardinal

10:00 AM: White-throated Sparrow

11:00 AM: White-breasted Nuthatch

12:00 PM: House Finch

Smart Light Sensor (CDS)

The clock is equipped with a light sensor located above the 12 o'clock position. This sensor automatically silences the bird songs when the room is dark, ensuring peaceful nights. The sounds will resume when sufficient light is detected. For optimal performance, place the clock in a location with consistent ambient light during the day and darkness at night.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean the clock, gently wipe the surface with a clean, dry, soft cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or polishes, as these may damage the finish or internal components.

Battery Care

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc), or rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) batteries.
- Replace all batteries at the same time to prevent leakage or malfunction.
- If the clock will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent potential damage

from leakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sound or Incorrect Bird Song:**

Ensure batteries are installed correctly with proper polarity and are not depleted. Verify that the clock hands were set to 12:50 **before** battery installation. If the bird song is incorrect, use the "Test" button on the back to cycle through the sounds until it matches the current hour.

- **Clock Not Keeping Time:**

Check the battery in the clock movement compartment. Replace if necessary. Ensure the handset knob is not loose.

- **Sounds Not Playing During the Day:**

The light sensor may be detecting insufficient light. Move the clock to a brighter area or ensure the sensor (located above 12 o'clock) is not obstructed.

- **Sounds Playing at Night:**

The light sensor may be detecting ambient light. Ensure the room is sufficiently dark for the sensor to activate the silent mode. Adjust placement if necessary.



