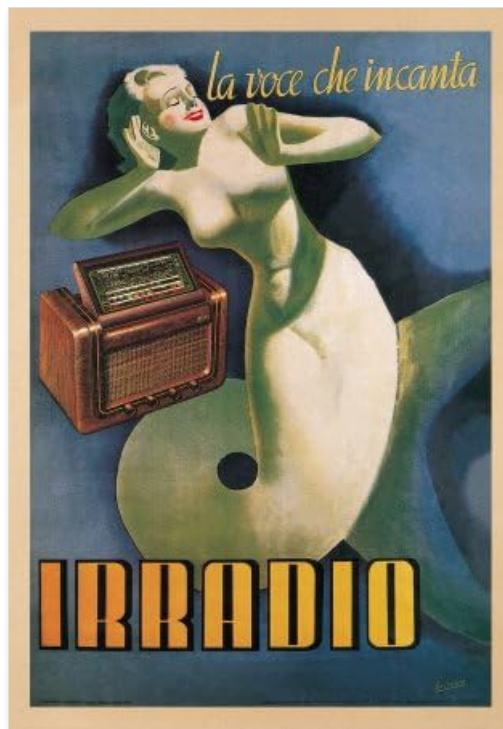

DISPLAYING YOUR PRINT

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Warping or Creasing

Warping can occur in environments with high humidity or significant temperature fluctuations. Ensure the print is displayed or stored in a stable environment. For unframed prints, storing them flat under light, even pressure can help. Severe creases may require professional restoration.
