INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the proper installation, maintenance, and understanding of your WIX Filters 24687 Cabin Air Panel. This filter is designed to improve the air quality inside your vehicle's cabin by filtering out dust, pollen, and other airborne particles.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Safety First: Before beginning any installation, ensure your vehicle is turned off and parked on a level surface. Consult your vehicle's owner's manual for specific instructions regarding cabin air filter location and replacement procedures, as these can vary significantly by make and model.

1. **Locate the Cabin Air Filter Housing:** In most vehicles, the cabin air filter is located behind the glove compartment, under the hood near the windshield, or under the dashboard. Refer to your vehicle's manual for the exact location.
2. **Access the Filter:** This may involve opening or removing the glove compartment, or unfastening clips/screws on the filter housing cover.
3. **Remove the Old Filter:** Carefully pull out the old cabin air filter. Note the direction of the airflow arrow on the old filter, if present. This is crucial for correct installation of the new filter.

4. **Clean the Housing (Optional but Recommended):** Use a vacuum cleaner or a damp cloth to remove any debris, leaves, or dirt from the filter housing before installing the new filter.
5. **Install the New Filter:** Insert the WIX Filters 24687 Cabin Air Panel into the housing. Ensure the airflow arrow on the new filter points in the same direction as the old filter (typically towards the vehicle's interior). Do not force the filter; it should slide in smoothly.
6. **Secure the Housing:** Reattach the filter housing cover and secure any clips or screws. Reinstall the glove compartment if it was removed.
7. **Test the System:** Start your vehicle and turn on the HVAC system to ensure proper airflow and operation.

If you are unsure about any step, it is recommended to seek assistance from a qualified automotive technician.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your cabin air filter is essential for maintaining optimal air quality and HVAC system performance. The WIX Filters 24687 Cabin Air Panel should be inspected and replaced periodically.

- **Inspection:** It is recommended to inspect your cabin air filter every 12,000 to 15,000 miles or once a year, whichever comes first. More frequent inspection may be necessary if you drive in dusty conditions or areas with high pollen counts.
- **Replacement:** Replace the filter when it appears dirty, clogged, or if you notice a decrease in airflow from your vehicle's vents or an unusual odor. Refer to your vehicle's owner's manual for specific replacement intervals.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues after installing or during the use of your WIX Filters 24687 Cabin Air Panel, consider the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Airflow from Vents	Filter installed incorrectly (airflow direction), or filter is clogged/dirty.	Check filter orientation (airflow arrow). Replace filter if dirty. Ensure housing is properly sealed.
Unpleasant Odors in Cabin	Filter is saturated with moisture or contaminants, or mold/mildew growth.	Replace the cabin air filter. Consider cleaning the HVAC system if odors persist.
Whistling or Hissing Noise	Filter not seated properly, or housing not fully closed.	Re-seat the filter and ensure all clips and screws on the housing are securely fastened.
