Installation

Safety First: Before beginning any installation, ensure the power to your heating and cooling system is turned OFF at the main circuit breaker or fuse box. Failure to do so can result in electrical shock or equipment damage.

Professional Installation Recommended: If you are unfamiliar with electrical wiring or HVAC systems, it is highly recommended to consult a qualified HVAC technician for installation.

Compatibility

The CT87N1001 thermostat is designed for specific heating and cooling systems. Please refer to the compatibility chart below to ensure your system is supported.



Figure 4: Compatibility chart for the CT87N Thermostat. It is compatible with Heating Only (Single Stage, Furnace/Forced Air, Hot Water and Steam Radiant Heat, Gas Fireplaces (24V)) and Cooling Only (Single Stage). It is NOT compatible with Multistage, Heat Pump with Auxiliary Heat, Heat Pump w/o Auxiliary Heat, Gravity Radiant Heat, 750 Millivolt, Electric Baseboard Heat (120-240 Volts), Convectors, or Radiant Ceiling Heat systems.

Mounting and Wiring

1. **Remove Old Thermostat:** Carefully remove your old thermostat from the wall. Take a picture of the existing wiring connections before disconnecting any wires. Label each wire with the terminal it was connected to.
2. **Mounting Plate:** Secure the new thermostat's mounting plate to the wall using the provided screws and anchors. Ensure it is level.
3. **Connect Wires:** Connect the labeled wires to the corresponding terminals on the new thermostat. Refer to the wiring diagram in the product packaging for specific connections.
4. **Attach Thermostat:** Once wiring is complete, carefully attach the thermostat body to the mounting plate.
5. **Restore Power:** Turn the power back ON at the main circuit breaker or fuse box.

Operating Instructions

The Honeywell Home CT87N1001 thermostat is designed for simple, manual operation.

Setting the Temperature

- To adjust the desired temperature, gently rotate the outer ring of the thermostat.
- Align the red indicator on the dial with your preferred temperature setting. The thermostat will maintain this temperature.

System Mode Selection

Use the switch located on the top of the thermostat to select the desired system mode:

- **HEAT:** Activates the heating system to maintain the set temperature.
- **OFF:** Turns off both heating and cooling systems.
- **COOL:** Activates the cooling system to maintain the set temperature.

Fan Operation

Use the switch located on the side of the thermostat to control the fan:

- **ON:** The fan runs continuously, regardless of whether the heating or cooling system is active.
- **AUTO:** The fan runs only when the heating or cooling system is actively operating.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the thermostat with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust or smudges. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Check:** While the thermostat is primarily line-powered, some models may include a small button-cell battery (e.g., #2450) for the anticipator or to maintain settings during power outages. If the thermostat exhibits erratic behavior, checking or replacing this battery may resolve the issue. Consult a professional if unsure.

Troubleshooting

If you experience issues with your thermostat, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power/System Not Responding:**
 - Check if the main power to your HVAC system is turned on at the circuit breaker.
 - Ensure all wiring connections are secure and correctly matched.
- **Incorrect Temperature Readings:**
 - Ensure the thermostat is not exposed to direct sunlight, drafts, or heat sources (e.g., lamps, appliances) that could affect its temperature sensor.
 - Verify the thermostat is securely mounted to the wall.
- **System Cycles On/Off Frequently (Short Cycling):**
 - This could indicate an issue with the thermostat's anticipator or a system imbalance. If applicable, check the internal battery as mentioned in the Maintenance section.
 - Consult an HVAC professional if the issue persists.

For complex issues or if troubleshooting steps do not resolve the problem, contact a qualified HVAC service technician.
