INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the Capcom Classics Collection Reloaded game for the Sony PSP. It covers game setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure an optimal gaming experience. This collection features a variety of classic Capcom arcade titles, offering both single-player and multiplayer options.

SETUP

Follow these steps to begin playing Capcom Classics Collection Reloaded on your Sony PSP:

1. **Power On Your PSP:** Ensure your Sony PSP system is charged or connected to a power source. Slide the POWER switch to the ON position.
2. **Insert the UMD:** Open the UMD drive cover on the back of your PSP. Carefully insert the Capcom Classics Collection Reloaded UMD with the label facing upwards until it clicks into place. Close the UMD drive cover securely.
3. **Select Game:** From the PSP XMB (XrossMediaBar) menu, navigate to the "Game" column. Select the "UMD" icon.

4. **Start Game:** Choose "Capcom Classics Collection Reloaded" from the list and press the **X** button to start the game.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the game has loaded, you will be presented with the main menu. From here, you can select individual games, access bonus content, or configure settings.

Game Selection and Controls

Use the PSP's D-pad or analog stick to navigate menus and select games. The **X** button typically confirms selections, while the **O** button cancels or goes back.

During gameplay, controls will vary slightly depending on the classic game chosen. Generally, the D-pad or analog stick controls movement, and the face buttons (**X**, **O**, **Square**, **Triangle**) are used for actions like attacking, jumping, or firing. The **L** and **R** shoulder buttons may also be utilized for specific game functions.

Special Features

- **Wireless Multiplayer:** Connect with other PSP users for 2 to 3 player wireless gameplay. Refer to your PSP system's manual for detailed instructions on establishing ad-hoc connections.
- **UMD Share Play:** Certain titles support playing with friends using only a single UMD. Follow on-screen prompts within the game to initiate this feature.
- **Gallery Mode:** Explore a wealth of bonus content including game histories, classic artwork, and music. This mode also provides tips to enhance your gameplay.
- **Capcom Coin System:** As you play, you will earn coins. These coins can be used in a virtual slot machine within the game to unlock additional content such as tips, tricks, arranged music, artwork, and cheats. Unlocked cheats can be toggled ON or OFF from the game's options.
- **In-Game Saving:** The game automatically saves your progress when you exit a specific classic title, allowing you to resume from where you left off. Note that opting to spend coins in the slot machine may reset this temporary save.

- **Screen Size Adjustment:** During gameplay, press the **SELECT** button on your PSP to cycle through various screen display options. Many games offer multiple aspect ratios, while certain shooter titles (e.g., 1942, 1943, Vulgus) provide up to five options, including vertical screen orientations for an authentic arcade experience.

Proper care of your UMD and PSP system will ensure longevity and optimal performance.

- **UMD Handling:** Always hold the UMD by its edges. Avoid touching the data surface.
- **Cleaning the UMD:** If the UMD becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the UMD in its original case or a protective UMD storage case when not in use to prevent scratches and dust accumulation.
- **PSP System Care:** Keep your PSP system clean and free from dust. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while using Capcom Classics Collection Reloaded, consider the following common solutions:

- **Game Not Loading:**
 - Ensure the UMD is correctly inserted into the PSP's UMD drive and the cover is closed.
 - Check if the PSP system has sufficient battery charge or is connected to a power source.
 - Inspect the UMD for visible scratches or damage. If damaged, the UMD may need replacement.
- **Gameplay Issues (Freezing, Glitches):**
 - Restart the PSP system and try loading the game again.
 - Ensure the UMD is clean and free of smudges.
 - If using cheats unlocked via the Capcom Coin System, try disabling them to see if they are causing conflicts.
- **Wireless Multiplayer Connection Problems:**
 - Ensure all PSP systems are within close proximity and have their WLAN switches turned ON.
 - Verify that all players have the same game version.
 - Consult your PSP system's manual for detailed wireless connection troubleshooting.
