SETUP GUIDE

Connecting the Mouse

1. Locate an available USB port on your computer (desktop or laptop).
2. Insert the USB connector of the Logitech V100 mouse firmly into the USB port.
3. The operating system will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This is a Plug and Play device, so no additional software installation is typically required.
4. Once installed, the mouse cursor should appear on your screen and respond to mouse movements.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Mouse Functions

- **Left Button:** Used for selecting items, clicking links, and performing primary actions.
- **Right Button:** Used for accessing context menus and secondary functions.
- **Scroll Wheel (Middle Button):**
 - **Scrolling:** Roll the wheel up or down to scroll through documents and web pages vertically.
 - **Middle Click:** Press the scroll wheel down to activate middle-click functions, often used for opening links in new tabs.
 - **Tilt-Wheel (Side-to-Side Scrolling):** Tilt the scroll wheel to the left or right to scroll horizontally in applications that support this feature, such as spreadsheets or wide web pages.
 - **Zoom:** In compatible applications, tilting the scroll wheel while holding down a modifier key (e.g., Ctrl on Windows, Command on Mac) may activate zoom functionality.

Optical Tracking

The Logitech V100 utilizes precise optical technology, allowing it to track movement accurately on a variety of surfaces. For best performance, use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective surface. Avoid highly reflective or transparent surfaces like glass, as these may interfere with tracking.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** To clean the mouse, gently wipe its surface with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the device.
- **Optical Sensor:** Keep the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse clean and free from dust or debris to ensure accurate tracking. Do not attempt to open the mouse casing.
- **Cable Care:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the USB cable to prevent internal wire damage.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the mouse in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Mouse cursor does not move or is erratic.	Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into a working USB port. Try a different USB port. Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse. Try using the mouse on a different surface. Avoid glass or highly reflective surfaces. Restart your computer.
Buttons or scroll wheel are unresponsive.	Check for any physical obstructions around the buttons or scroll wheel. Ensure the mouse is properly connected to the computer. Test the mouse on another computer if possible to determine if the issue is with the mouse or the computer.
Mouse is not detected by the computer.	Verify the USB connection. Try a different USB port. Check your computer's Device Manager (Windows) or System Information (Mac) to see if the mouse is listed. You may need to update or reinstall USB drivers for your computer.
